The Trust also runs Teachers Training College and ITI for vocational courses. It has been a rare honour for the Trust to have Mahatma Gandhi as the First Chairman Trustee. It needs to be mentioned here that the Trust came into being as a result of the donation by Shri Anandilalji Podar for the upliftment of education in the Shekhawati region. 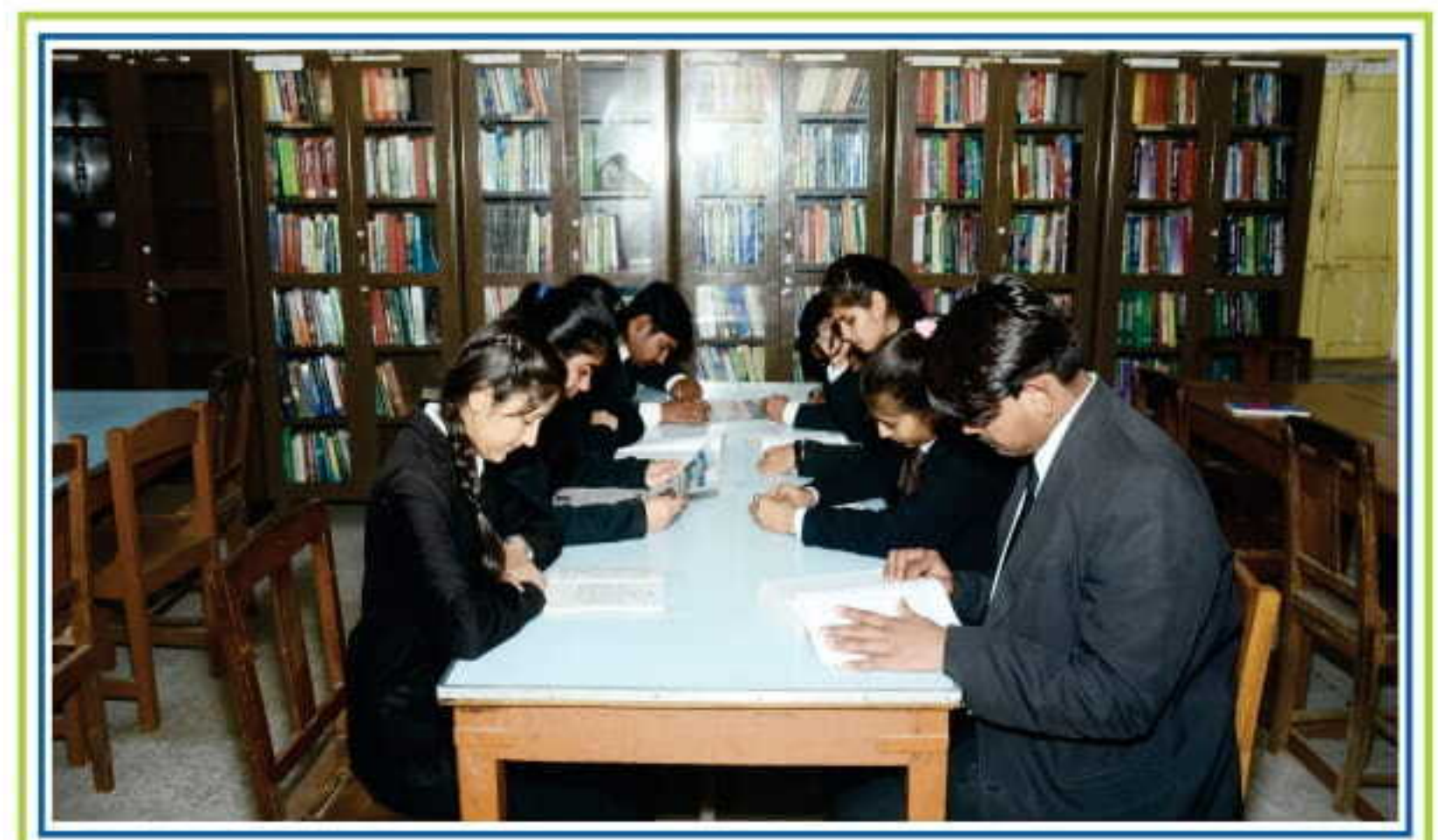

Computer Laboratories

We have two well-equipped, well-furnished, modern and air-conditioned computer labs. The labs are separate for undergraduate and postgraduate students. The entire system is supported with UPS backup. A 24 hours internet and online facility is available for the students and faculty to get connected to the world so that they can access the world and get information from across it to enhance their knowledge. The labs also have high speed broadband connection for uninterrupted internet connectivity.

Science Laboratories

All Science Departments of the College namely Botany, Zoology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Science, Geography and Information Technology have their separate laboratories of the finest quality. The Culture Rooms, Botanical Garden and Museum Zoology Museum with the Lab are some attractive parts of the respective laboratories. The laboratories are well-furnished, well-equipped and updated with the latest instruments and equipments needed by the students to conduct their experiments in labs. We have separate laboratories for undergraduate and postgraduate students.

Residential Facility: Hostels

The College has separate hostels for boys and girls. The residential facility is provided on priority basis to the students of M.Sc. & professional courses at the Management Institute. Students belonging to any faculty/Programme can avail of the hostel facility. The hostel wardens and mess facilities ensure that students get a homely atmosphere and can stay comfortably. Hostels also have internet and recreation facilities. Fees for the hostels are charged separately (from the boarders only).

Sports Complex

The college has a large sports complex with a spacious Indoor Games Arena, a swimming pool, large football fields and courts for volleyball, basketball, tennis and a gym. NCC (National Cadet Corps)

The College has one NCC unit functioning under the 3 Rajasthan battalion with an efficient Associate NCC Officer (ANO). Undergraduate students of any stream/faculty of the college below the age of 20 years can get themselves enrolled in the first year of NCC. The duration of the NCC course for appearing in 'C' Certificate Examinations is three years.

The students joining NCC have a special opportunity of serving the nation by becoming officers in the armed forces. Students having a 'C' certificate of NCC are exempted from appearing in the written examination held by the Indian Defence Academy. Such students are directly interviewed by the Service Selection Board and are recruited as officers if found medically fit.

Mr. Vinod Kashawa, a student of our College (2011-12) had been selected for participating in the Republic Day Parade. He had been one of the sixty cadets selected out of 1600 cadets from all over India. Sgt. Rajesh Nehra had been selected for the Para Jumping Course (one month) at the Air Force Stadium, Agra. He was the only male cadet from Rajasthan selected for jumping from an airforce plane from the height of 2500 feet. Recently, four of our NCC cadets have been selected in the Indian Air Force and the best NCC award was given to the unit of our College.

Mr. Hemant Bhichchar (Under officer in NCC), a student of our College participated in the Republic Day Parade in New Delhi in the year 2019.

NSS (National Service Scheme)

The College has two units of the NSS functioning under the ministry of HRD (Human Resource Development), government of India. Apart from the plantation drives and welfare work aimed at women and children, the NSS units of the College carry out a special programme to create awareness against drug abuse, AIDS and several social ills. Under the special camping programme of the NSS units, three villages have been adopted for dedicated and focused services. The adoption of village for concentrated services has now become the regular features of the NSS programmes at the College. The government of Rajasthan has recognized the social service rendered by two units through award of certificates during past sessions.

Scouts & Guides

16. CODE OF CONDUCT

- (a) No club or organization of any kind shall be formed by the students without the prior written permission of the college Principal.
- (b) No meeting/assembly shall be held by the students without prior written permission of the Principal. Students are also required to seek the permission of the Principal in writing to invite guests to meetings/assemblies.
- (c) The students are required to maintain decorum in the college and use their free time usefully at the NRSC (Non-resident Student Center) or at the library. Students must not aimlessly roam around the campus.
- (d) The students must not damage any college furniture and property. They should avoid crossing the lawn and plucking flowers or leaves of plants.
- (e) Students must note that their requirement of a good character certificate. It shall be fulfilled only if they maintain discipline and decorum in the college.
- (f) The students must note that smoking and use of other tobacco products, intoxicants or drug in any form at public places such as an educational institution has been banned by the government through an act of legislation. Therefore, the students found smoking or using intoxicants of any kind in the college campus shall be penalized.
- (g) Students must ensure at least 75% attendance in aggregate in their subsidiary, compulsory and optional subjects/papers in order to be eligible to appear in the University examinations.
- (h) Following the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the admission of a student will be cancelled if he/she is found indulging in ragging of any sort. Any instance of this nature will also be reported to the police.
- (i) Uploading Program Video/ Photos on social media which may harm the reputation and good-will of the institution will be treated as a serious offence. Strict action will be taken against students indulging in such offences.

17. ADMISSION RULES

The prospectus with the admission form is available at the cash counter of the college on a pre-payment of Rs. 500/-. A duly filled in admission form with attested copies of all the required documents is to be submitted at the registration counter.

Documents required with the admission form:

- (a) Three self-addressed post cards.
- (b) Original mark-sheet of the qualifying examination with three photocopies.
- (c) Photo copies of the mark-sheet of part I, II and III of bachelor's programme (for admission in PG previous class).
- (d) Two recent passport size photographs.
- (e) Transfer certificate (for new entrants).
- (f) Candidates qualifying from other universities/boards need to submit their original migration certificate for enrollment in this university.
- (g) Photocopy of secondary school certificate/mark-sheet having date of birth (for new entrants).
- (h) Certificate of participation in inter school/collegiate games & sports, NCC or cultural events for bonus marks in merit for admission (if any).
- (i) SC/ST/OBC students should enclose certificate of their category/caste.

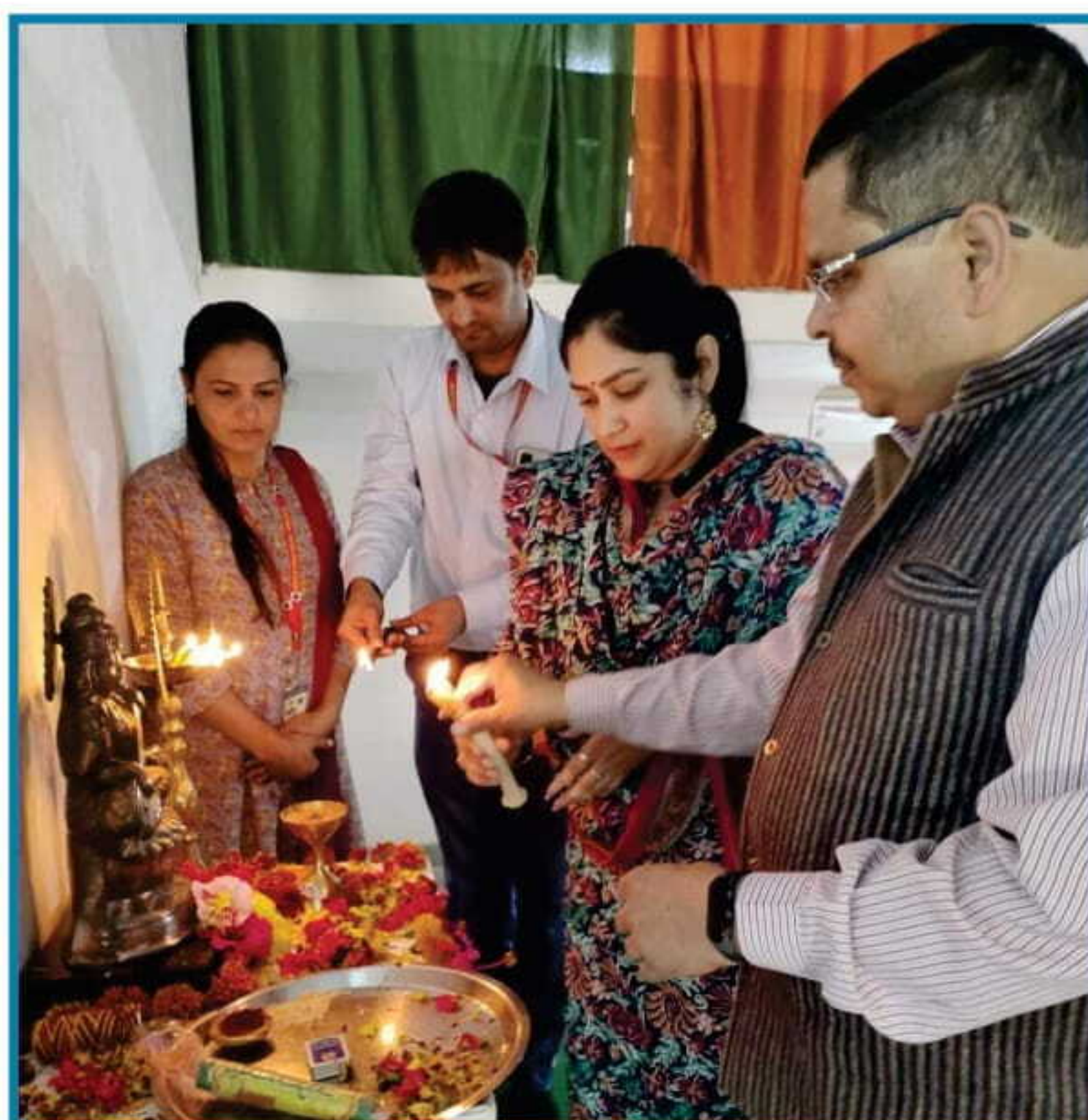
- The eligibility for admission to various courses in the college is in accordance with the norms determined by the Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Shekhawati University, Sikar and the admission rules published by the Commissioner of College Education, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur.
- Last date for the submission of the filled in admission form for the students of part I of B.A., B.Com., B.Sc., BBA, BCA will be the same as announced by the University/Directorate of College Education. For other classes, the last date for submission of the filled in admission form is June 30 of the respective session or 15 days after the declaration of result of the qualifying examination.
- For postgraduate classes, the last date for the submission of the admission form is 15 days after the declaration of result of the qualifying examination.
- The claims for reservation and relaxation in admission are subject to availability of seats and the rules laid down by the Commissioner of the College Education, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur.
- A candidate recommended for admission shall have to pay fees by the date notified by the college office. In case he/she fails to do it, his/her admission shall stand cancelled.
- The Principal reserves the right to reject any application for admission without assigning any reason.
- Students are normally not allowed to change their subjects once opted. Hence, they must choose the optional groups carefully. Subject to the availability of seats, students can change faculty/optional groups or subject with the permission of Principal within 15 days of the last date of admission. A student wanting change of subject will be permitted to change only one subject. A student can avail the facility only once on payment of Rs.50/.
- The management has the discretion to close a class/section having less than 10 students in a session. In such cases all the fees paid by the students of the class, except that for the prospectus, will be refunded.
- Registration and identity card will be refunded on the production of a “No Dues” certificate. Such students must ensure his/her eligibility to the course in which he/she is admitted.

University Ordinance 88

Students must maintain proper discipline in the college campus. They must know that any instance of indiscipline comes under the University Ordinance 88 which has following provisions :

- i. The Principal may suspend a student who has been accused and found guilty of serious criminal charge(s), grave misconduct and persistent negligence of work or misbehavior.
- ii. The student found guilty of such charges(s) will be suspended from the college, minimum for one month or maximum for an academic session.
- iii. The suspended student cannot be admitted to any other college without the permission of the Principal of the concerned college from which he/she was suspended.
- iv. The student found guilty of such charges can be barred from appearing for the University examinations.

20. SCHOLARSHIPS

The State and Central Government Scholarships:

Scholarships are given to wards of freedom fighters and of the soldiers who laid down their lives in the Indo-China war of 1962 and Indo-Pak war of 1965.

There are also scholarships for daughters of retired soldiers, meritorious girls, SC and ST students studying outside Rajasthan. Need-cum-merit scholarships are given to the first class students by the state Government. The details of all these scholarships are available at the college office.

The following scholarships are offered by the Management of the college to the students of Part I of all undergraduate courses:

- (a) Rs.1200/- to the students securing 75% or more in qualifying examination
- (b) Rs. 1200/- to the sisters of existing college students Rs.1200/- to students of BPL category

The above scholarships are subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- (a) Attendance of applicants should be more than 75% for the academic session in the college.
- (b) The applicants must have appeared in all the tests/home-assignments, pre-university exams conducted by the college.

The scholarship will be awarded on the last working day of the academic session. A student will be eligible just for any one of these scholarships.

The applications for the scholarship shall be accepted only from the regular students who have paid the fees and the college dues. The applicants for scholarships are required to submit their applications in the prescribed form issued by the office. The applications must be accompanied with the attested photocopy of the marks-sheet of the last examination.

The applicant for any scholarship should fulfill the following essential requirements:

- (a) He/She should have regularly participate in the curricular activities of the college.
- (b) He/She should have passed the last examination at least in second division and should have made noticeable progress in studies.
- (c) He/She should make his/her claim for scholarship in the manner prescribed.
- (d) The scholarships may be revoked if the student fails to appear in the examination.

Late Shri Kantikumar R. Podar Memorial Scholarship:

The Anandilal Podar Trust, Nawalgarh provides Late Shri Kantikumar R. Podar Memorial Scholarship to those eligible students who will obtain more than 70% marks in their previous examination the students are required to submit the scholarship form in stipulated time.

21. FEES AND CHARGES

All students, whether existing or fresh seekers have to submit an application form, complete in all respects along with registration charge of Rs. 500/-

The fees and charges may be paid in total or maximum in two installments as under :

1st Installment: ($2/3^{\text{rd}}$ of total dues)-at the time of admission

2nd Installment: ($1/3^{\text{rd}}$ of total dues)-between 1st and 31st December of the current session

Late fee : Rs. 5/-per day from 1st January, 2023. If a student fails to pay the fee and late fee by this date even, his/her regular admission in the college shall stand cancelled.

If a student leaves the college after admission, the fees deposited by him/her shall be forfeited. In case he/she leaves the college after the expiry of the last date of admission, he/she will be required to pay the remaining installment (s) of the fees of the course. If the student leaving the college does not clear the dues, Transfer Certificate, Character Certificate and No Dues Certificate will not be issued to him/her.

Students will be required to pay a forwarding fee as prescribed by the University at the time of submission of the examination form.

The fees and charges, except Caution Money, are not refundable in any case. The Caution Money can be claimed within three years from the date of leaving the college. No claim for the refund of Caution Money will be entertained after the lapse of three years.

In the case of unforeseen circumstances, the fees & charges are subject to change in the middle of the academic session by the college Management.

40% discount in tuition fees would be given to all faculty or staff member working in any of the institutions run by the Anandilal Podar Trust, should his/her wards get enrolled in any of the programmes in Podar College.

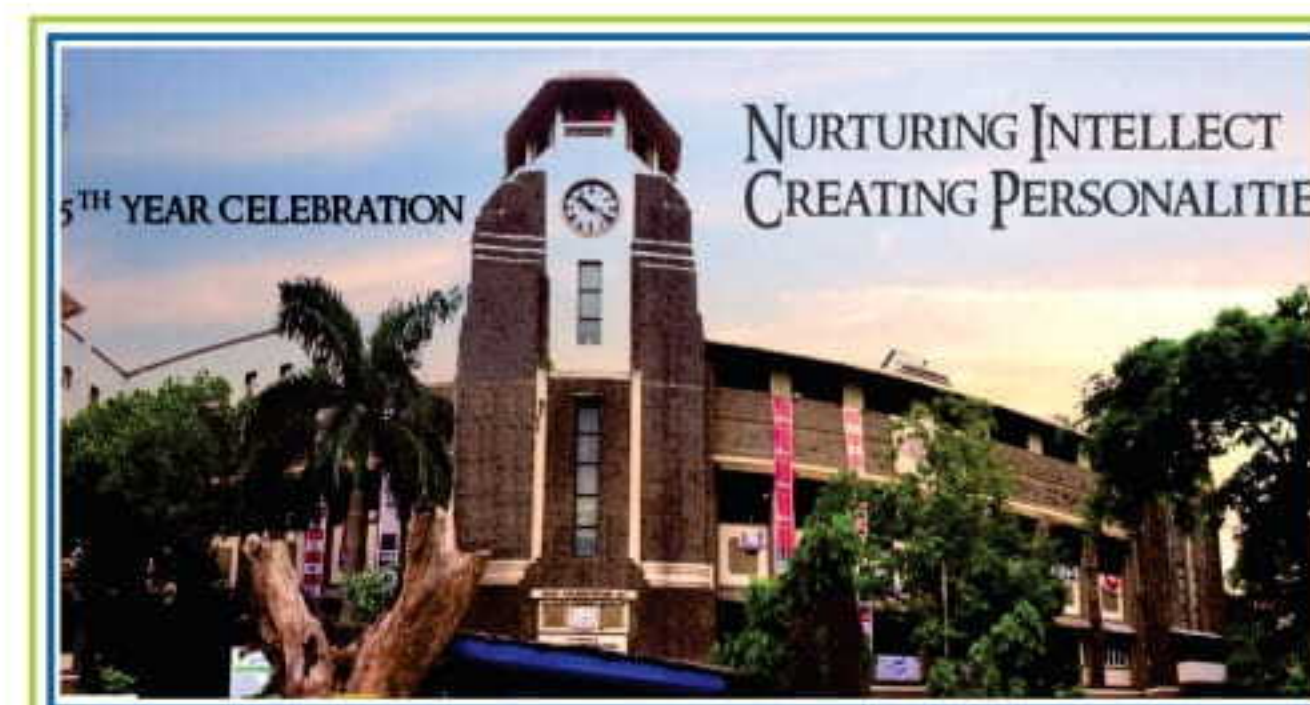

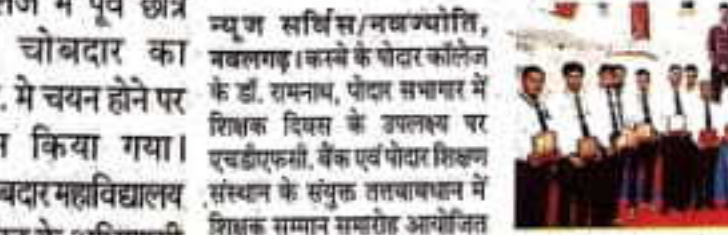

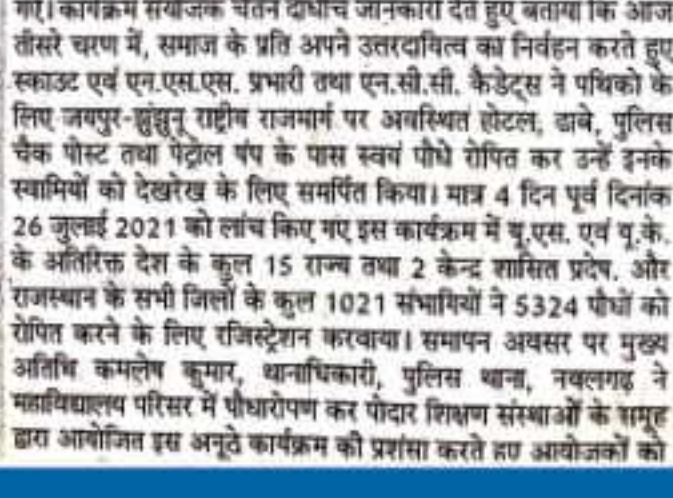
