

This Memorandum of Understanding is made at Pune on 15 day of July 2021

BETWEEN

Seth Gyaniram Bansidhar Podar College, Nawalgarh, Rajasthan 333042 here in after referred to as "**THE COLLEGE**" (Which term shall so far as the context admits be deemed to mean and include its successors and assignees) of the First Part,

AND

Rubicon Skill Development Private Limited a Company incorporated and registered under the Companies Act, 2013, having its Corporate office at 9th Floor, Tower 1, Fountainhead, Nagar Road, Vimannagar, Pune - 411014, Maharashtra, hereinafter referred to as "**Rubicon**" (which term shall so far as the context admits be deemed to mean and include its successors, administrators, executors and assignees) of the Second Part.

1. Introduction

THE COLLEGE has decided to partner with RUBICON for the conduct of Connect with Work Program (hereinafter referred to as "Training Program") at THE COLLEGE.

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2. THE COLLEGE Responsibilities:

- 2.1. Shall nominate one person with adequate accountability and responsibility to coordinate the Training Program. He / She would act as the single point of contact for the proposed Training Program.
- 2.2. Shall make available the infrastructure (including IT infrastructure, applications and connectivity) required to conduct the Training Program.
- 2.3. Shall provide all the support services and facilities to RUBICON during the conduct of the said Training Program. Adequate power backup through UPS and DG supplies during the training sessions
- 2.4. Shall coordinate with **RUBICON** and facilitate conduct of all the assessments including the assessment to be conducted by the external agency (if any) identified by **RUBICON**, as per schedule communicated by **RUBICON**.
- 2.5. Provide lodging, wherever available, as per the standards of RUBICON for faculty conducting the Training Programme for the total duration of the Training Program plus two days (one day prior and one day after closure). The lodging so planned to be provided should be with independent room (with attached toilet), regular water supply, clean, with access to boarding facilities, should have well lit approach and surroundings, have adequate safety & protection and peaceful environment.
- 2.6. Shall share the details of students in a prescribed format to ensure that there is no duplication of student data.
- 2.7. This is a multi-year program to create social impact. The college shall share few details to assess the impact of the program. For e.g. Placement details of trained students will be required to assess the impact of the program from one year to another year.

3. RUBICON Responsibilities:

3.1. Will provide necessary training as per Training Program requirements and curriculum for delivery as per Annexure I to this MOU

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- 3.2. Will provide suitable faculties for the training exclusive for classroom training/Virtual training
- 3.3. Will conduct assessment of its own and also arrange external assessment as required.
- 4. Other Terms & Conditions:

The following are other terms and conditions of engagement:

- 4.1. Batch Size: The batch size would need to be a min of 35 students and max of 50 students or as mutually agreed.
- 4.2. Each student would be made available for the Training Program for specified number of hours per day for the duration of the Training Program
- 4.3. Pre-assessment & Selection: RUBICON may carry out pre-assessment of the students who have applied for the course and shortlist the select candidates to undergo the Training Program. The final decision on selection of candidates eligible to take the Training Program shall be with RUBICON.
- 4.4. Training Program schedule:

4.4.1. Training Program scheduled commencement date is 23 July 2021

4.5. Commercials:

4.5.1. Training Fees: The training Fees is as follows,

Since this is a CSR funded Program there is no fee payable by THE COLLEGE for this **Training Program**

4.5.2. Payment Terms Not Applicable

4.6. Certification:

Students who are successful in the assessment conducted by RUBICON shall be awarded a certificate post completion of the training program.

4.7. Term of engagement:

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This MoU is valid from the date the MOU is made for a period of 3 (Three) years, however both parties agree that based on mutual agreement, the terms may be extended. Both parties also agree that terms may be renegotiated.

4.8. Limitations and Warranties :

Both parties agree that it would be their endeavour to prevent any liability arising out of default or non-compliance of the MoU terms by the other party.

4.9. Termination:

- 4.9.1. Both parties can terminate the MoU with a prior written thirty (30) day notice on default of terms of non-adherence to any condition or responsibilities by the other party as outlined in this MoU in case such default is not rectified within such 30 days.
- 4.9.2. Each party shall be at liberty to terminate this MOU with a written notice period of3 (three) months to the other party without any compensation and seeking legal redress.
- 4.9.3. Both parties also agree that it would be their professional endeavour that despite any termination of the MOU, progress would continue, without any prejudice to the ongoing Training Program, which would be without any hindrance and would be progressed for completion.

5. General Terms:

- 5.1. Both the parties may receive information proprietary to other party (the Confidential Information) in the course of performance of their obligations under this MOU. Confidential Information is not meant to include any information which (a) is publicly available (b) is rightfully received by the parties from third parties without accompanying secrecy obligations; (c) is already in either party's possession and was lawfully received from sources other than the parties or (d) is independently developed by the parties. The two bodies understand and acknowledge that the Confidential Information is valuable and confidential and agrees that it will at all times be kept in trust to be disclosed only to such persons as have a "need to know" the same for the effective implementation of this MOU and that it will only be used by the parties for the benefit of others.
- 5.2. Both the parties understand and agree that all written or other tangible data and documentation developed or procured by the other party in performing its obligations

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under this MOU, whether in printed or electronic form, belongs to other party and that other party will have all rights, titles and interests therein.

5.3. Both parties shall not use the name and brand of other party in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other. However RUBICON will have the right to use the testimonials/stories/case studies of students/College/University who have been the part of the Training Program for promoting the Connect with Work Program.

6. Jurisdiction:

In the event of any litigation, the court of jurisdiction shall be Pune.

7. Indemnification

Both parties agree to indemnify each other and hold the other party harmless from and against any claim, loss, liability, or expense, including, but not limited to, damages, patent, and trademark infringement, costs and attorneys' fees, arising out of or in connection with any acts or omissions of their agents or employees, as related to the terms of this MoU.

Any claim, compensation, case initiated by any student against RUBICON/CSR DONOR in relation to the Training Program due to any acts or omissions of THE COLLEGE, RUBICON shall be defended and contested by THE COLLEGE at their sole expenses and cost keeping RUBICON/CSR DONOR indemnified from the same.

8. Limitation of Liability:

Except for the indemnification obligations, both parties agree that the liability would be limited to the amount of actual transactions between the two parties

9. Notices:

Any notices under this MOU will be sent by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, to the respective address of Parties as contained in this MOU. Such notice will be effective upon its mailing as specified.

10. Intellectual Property Rights

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- 10.1. - 10.2. Upon expiration of this MoU, or two years period of time from the date of completion of the courses, whichever is later, each party hereby agrees that it shall not make any claim on the Trade Name or the copyrights of the other, which belongs exclusively to the other party, nor shall either party use any trade name which is deceptively or confusingly similar to the trade name of the other.

11. Force Majeure:

- 11.1. Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfil and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.
- 11.2. Any extraordinary event, which cannot be controlled by the parties, shall for the purpose of this MOU be considered as a Force Majeure event. Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority. Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions

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whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.



- 4. Enable cross mobility of researchers, technical staff and faculty of member institutes through efforts such as (but not limited to): -
 - a. providing open access to common facilities such as libraries, laboratories, etc., the cluster should ensure all public academic institutions in its network are using the I-STEM portal
 - b. setting up common shuttle services between institutions
 - c. enabling cross-institutional credit courses for PhD students
- Collaborate with other cluster members to seek grants from public and private sector for creation of dedicated facilities patent cells, technology transfer cells, science museums, Center of Excellences, etc. for all.

- Provide support and infrastructure for incubation of early-stage ideas of researchers of member institutes all the way to their conversion to commercial products/technologies.
- 8. Support the cluster in building connections with the 'State S&T Council' and 'State Innovation Council/Society' where present, to help to address the regional problems.
- 9. Work with the cluster to create inter-institutional research teams to work with local government (state/municipal) to identify regional issues and to undertake R&D projects targeting alleviation of these local issues using latest science and technology solutions.
- 10. To work in close association with the Jodhpur City Knowledge and Innovation Foundation which has been formed as section 8 company (non-profit) to carry forward and sustain the activities of Jodhpur City Knowledge and Innovation Cluster

- 1. Collaborate with other cluster members on studies/collection of data/holding meets/conferences/seminars for making recommendations to the Government of India for policy on higher education, science and technology and innovation, etc.
- 2. Partner with other cluster members to apply for grants from public and private funding agencies in a consortium manner to fund collaborative R&D science projects which
 - a. aligned with the national missions and aspire to become national and global leaders in selected domains.
 - b. provide R&D consultancy for global industries
- 3. Support the cluster in building formal partnership with international universities, research organization, foundations, etc.

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

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

Whereas the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, constituted under the Company Secretaries Act, 1980 to develop and regulate the profession of Company Secretaries in India being solely authorised to conduct coaching and examinations for the award of Professional qualification / Membership of the Institute and whereas Gyaniram Bansidhar Podar College, Nawalgarh would create synergy between the university education and professional education to enhance the quality of education imparted to the ICSI students, the study centres

- Study centre shall function from the premises of recognised university/ college having proper recommendations of the concerned Regional Council/Chapter.
- Study centre shall be run by faculty or Department of Commerce or any other department having relevance to CS Course, by whatever nomenclature, on selfsustainable basis as per these guidelines.
- 3. The respective department of the university/ college shall operate and manage the ICSI study centre. Study centre shall in no case be termed as an agent or a partner or a representative of ICSI except for the limited purpose of providing class room teaching to CS students and other responsibilities covered in the agreement between the two Institutions.
- 4. Head of respective department of university / college in which the study centre has been set up or his representative will be designated as Director of the CS Study Centre.

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- 5. Study Centre shall not engage itself any activity or deal with a matter which are prejudicial to the interests and image of the Institute
- 6. These study centres shall be entitled to use the words and description ""ICSI Nawalgarh, Jhunjhunu Study Centre"
- 7. The study centres would have full autonomy in deciding the fee to be charged from the students for the Class Room Teaching activity but the Institute would not provide any financial support/compensation to the study centres on any account.
- 8. ICSI Head Office/Regional Council/Chapter shall have no share in the revenue generated by respective study centres.
- 9. The Study Centre shall impart education with best faculty for various stages of ICSI Course Curriculum on the lines prescribed by ICSI.
- 10. The Study Centre shall conduct Career Counselling, suitably advertise and attract students for enrolment to CS Course and disseminate information regarding Company Secretaryship course
- 11. Facilitating registrations to the CS Course through on-line mode. The Fee will be accepted by the Institute through online mode and the University/ College shall provide reasonable infrastructure (computer with internet connectivity, scanner, etc.) to enable the students to register online for CS Course. Students who are not having Credit/ Debit Cards may remit the fee through Bank Challan in which case cash can be deposited with designated banks (at present Canara Bank).
- 12. Provide at least one room space for ICSI representative office at University/ college campus.
- 13. Students of study centre shall be allowed access to the library of concerned department in which the study centre has been setup.
- 14. Members of Central Council, Regional Councils of ICSI or Members of the Chapter Managing Committees are not eligible to act as Faculty in the classes conducted by Study Centres.
- 15. The study centre shall submit quarterly MIS covering the activities conducted during such period like Details of Career Awareness Programmes/ Counselling Sessions conducted, Details of Registrations Facilitated(*) with registration number, Details of Classes Conducted with registration number of the students etc. to the Regional Council/Chapter to which it is attached with a copy to the ICSI HQ.

(*) as per format decided by the Institute from time to time.

- 16. The college shall maintain a permanent display board 'CS (Name of the City) Study Centre' on the boundary wall of the college and also within the premises where the study centre is located.
- 17. The designated room shall be properly maintained with daily cleaning, proper lighting and whitewash.
- 18. ICSI shall share and suggest ways and means for effective conduct of classes by the centre
- 19. ICSI shall Suggest / Depute faculty on specialised subjects as and when requested by the study centre



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- 35. ICSI shall not incur or suffer any kind of liability legal, financial or otherwise with regard to any obligations incurred by the study centre.
- 36. The Regional Director of respective Regional Council shall enter into an agreement between the respective University / college for setting up of Study Centre in its respective jurisdiction.
- 37. The agreement would be valid for a period of TWO years and can be extended further on year to year basis, as mutually agreed between the respective university/ college.
- 38. Unless the validity of the recognition renewed/extended, after due period, the study centre would not carry its activities. In case, a particular study centre is derecognised or validity withdrawn, it would stop the activities immediately.
- 39. It is the responsibility of the Centre to deduct TDS as applicable in respect of It shall also fulfil all the payment made by it for running the centre. compliances arising out of TDS deductions like remittance and filing of returns from time to time as prescribed under the law.
- 40. Likewise, the study centre would ensure to comply Service Tax provisions arising out of payment to the faculty handling the classes and for such other services as applicable.
 - 41. Study centre to maintain its accounts as per the standard and established practices and norms and get them audited at the close of financial year and send the audited accounts to the RC/Institute periodically for their information.
 - 42. It is also the responsibility of the Centre to comply with local laws if any, arising out of running of the centre.
 - 43. If the quality of teaching, infrastructure and other services (as envisaged under these guidelines) provided by the study centre is not upto the satisfaction of ICSI, it reserves the right to cancel/terminate the agreement without assigning any reason thereof. However, the cancellation/termination shall not affect the obligations in respect of the completion of the course in respect of any batches of classes that have been commenced and are in progress and fees for which have been collected from the participants by the study centre.
