GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL POLICY

The College has a Students' Grievance Redressal Committee. The functions of the Committee are to look into the complaints lodged by any student, and judge its merit. The Grievance Redressal Committee is also empowered to look into matters of harassment. Anyone with a genuine grievance may approach the Grievance Redressal Committee members in person. In case the person is unwilling to appear in self, grievances may be sent in writing. Grievances may also be sent through e-mail to the officer in-charge of Students' Grievance Redressal Committee or Principal.

Objective:-

The objective of the Grievance Redressal Committee is to develop a responsive and accountable attitude among all the stakeholders in order to maintain a harmonious educational atmosphere in the institute. A Grievance Redressal Committee has been constituted for the redressal of the problems reported by the Students of the College with the following objectives:

- Upholding the dignity of the College by ensuring strike free atmosphere in the College through promoting cordial Student-Student relationship and Student-teacher relationship etc.
- Encouraging the Students to express their grievances / problems freely and frankly, without any fear of being victimized.
- Suggestion / complaint Box have been installed in front of the Administrative Block in which the Students, who want to remain anonymous, put in writing their grievances and their suggestions for improving the Academics / Administration in the College.
- Advising Students of the College to respect the right and dignity of one another and show utmost restraint and patience whenever any occasion of rift arises. Advising All the Students to refrain from inciting Students against other Students, teachers and College administration.
- Advising all staffs to be affectionate to the Students and not behave in a vindictive manner towards any of them for any reason.



Responsibilities:

Provide an avenue for the aggrieved students to redress their individual grievances in order to have a healthy atmosphere among students, Institute. staff and management in the

- Comply with the UGC, CCE and affiliating University of PDSU Regulations.
- Discuss and resolve the grievances, if any received in writing from the concerned students.

Procedure:-

The setting of the Grievance Redressal Committee for students will be widely published. The students may feel free to put up a grievance and drop it in boxes placed at conspicuous locations.

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Student's Grievance Redressal & Anti Ragging Committee

Colleges and Institutions have constituted committee as preventive measures to stop the ragging among students and provide them a familiar environment to learn and develop both mentally and physically. In view of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP No. 24295 of 2006 dated 16 th May 2007 and in Civil Appeal number 887 of 2009, dated 08 th May 2009 the Institute of Public Enterprise (IPE) has constituted the following committee to eradicate / prohibit the ragging.

Grievance Redressal

Objective:-

The main objective of the Grievance Cell is to promote and maintain a conducive and harmonious educational environment among the students. The Students' Grievance Cell is constituted for the redressal of the problems reported by the students of the College. This is with the following objectives in mind.

- Grievance cell is formed in order to keep the healthy working atmosphere amongst staff, students and parents.
- This cell helps Students to record their complaints and solve their problems related to academics, resources and personal grievances freely and frankly without any fear of victimization.
- To keep the dignity of the college high by ensuring conflict free atmosphere in the College by promoting good Student-Student relationship and Student-teacher relationship.
- To ensure effective solution to the student grievances with an impartial and fair approach.
- In order to advising Students of the College to respect each other and be patient whenever any occasion of conflict arises.
- To advise all the students to refrain from stirring up students against other students, teachers and College administration.
- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in and outside the institution. Any violation of ragging and disciplinary rules should be urgently brought to the notice of the Principal. Ragging Complaints will be handled as per ragging rules.
- Woman Harassment complaints will be handled as per government guidelines by respective section.



Definition:-

Students may approach the cell to voice their grievances regarding academic matters, health services, library and other services. Any form of discontent or dissatisfaction on the part of the students can be informed to the cell. The Grievance cell also looks into matters of harassment. Anyone with a genuine grievance may approach the Coordinator or member of the Students' Grievance cell. Grievances may also be sent through e-mail to the Coordinator of the Students' Grievance Cell.

Function of Grievance Cell:-

- Complaint Boxes have been installed in the College campus in which the Students, who want to remain anonymous, can put in writing their grievances and their suggestions for improving the academics/administration in the College.
- Students can lodge a complaint.
- The person concerned can personally approach to any member of the Cell and can send email or write an application and submit to Cell Convener for grievances of any sort.
- The cases will be attended promptly on receipt of grievances from the students.
- The cell will review all cases and will act formally accordingly as per the Management policy.
- The cell will give report to the authority about the cases attended to and the number of pending cases, if any, which require direction and guidance from the higher authorities.

Scope:-

The Grievance Redressal Committee deals with Grievances received in writing from students about any of the following matters:-

Academic matters: - Related to timely use of duplicate mark sheet (DMC), transfer certificate, conduct certificate and other examination related matters.

Financial matters: - Related to dues and payments for various items from fee clerk, library, hostels, etc.

Library matters: - Issue and return of books, syllabus, photocopy, and university question papers. **Accommodation matters:** - Related to hostels.

Other matters: - Related to certain misgivings about conditions of sanitations, preparation of food, availability of transport, victimization by teachers etc.

About Anti Ragging Committee

Objectives of Anti Ragging Committee:-

Anti-Ragging Committee will be the supervisory and advisory committee in preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college Campus. The main objectives of this cell are as follows:

- 1. To make Students aware of the adverse effects of ragging.
- 2. To keep a continuous watch and vigil over ragging so as to prevent its occurrence and recurrence.
- 3. To bring to our notice of any ragging immediately.
- 4. To generate an atmosphere of discipline by sending a clear message that no act of ragging shall be tolerated and any act of ragging shall not go unnoticed and unpunished.

Definition:-

Ragging is an act of aggression committed by an individual or a group of individuals over another individual or a group of individuals where the first group. Ragging is not only a form of abuse, a serious act of indiscipline and misconduct but is also considered a "crime" under the Prohibition of Ragging Act.

Anti-Ragging Committee to ensure compliance with the provisions of Regulations as well as the provisions of any law for the time being in force concerning ragging and also to monitor and oversee



the performance of the Anti-Ragging Squad in prevention of ragging in the institution. As per the order of Supreme Court of India and subsequent Notification from University Grants Commission (UGC), ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students on:

- Any act of Indiscipline, Teasing or Handling with Rudeness.
- Any act that Prevents, Disrupts the Regular Academic Activity.
- Any activity which is likely to cause Annoyance, hardship, Psychological Harm or creates Fear or Apprehension.
- Any Act of Financial Extortion or Forceful Expenditure.
- Any Act of Physical Abuse causing Assault, Harm or danger to Health.
- Any Act of abuse by spoken words, emails, SMS or public insult etc.
- Any Act of injury or infringement of the fundamental right to the human dignity.
- Any Act of Wrongful Confinement, Kidnapping, molesting or committing unnatural offences, use of criminal forces, trespass or intimidation.
- Any unlawful assembly or conspiracy to ragging.

Punishable ingredients of Ragging:

- Abetment to ragging.
- Criminal conspiracy to rag.
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging.
- Public nuisance created during ragging.
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging.
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt.
- Wrongful restraint.
- Wrongful confinement.
- Use of criminal force.
- Assault as well as sexual offences or even unnatural offences.
- Extortion
- Criminal trespass.
- Offences against property.
- Criminal intimidation.
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above-mentioned offences against the victim.
- Physical or psychological humiliation.

The grievance and anti-ragging Committee may impose the following punishments depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established. Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging in the campus or even outside the campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments:

• Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.



- Withholding/Withdrawing scholarship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any Examinations.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, Youth festival etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the institution.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.

There are thirteen provisions of the IPC (Indian Penal Code) which can be used by a fresher who is being ragged to register an FIR (First Information Report) in the police station under whose jurisdiction-area the crime has taken place.

These sections are:

- 339. Wrongful restraint
- 340. Wrongful confinement
- 341. Punishment for wrongful restraint
- 342. Punishment for wrongful confinement
- 343. Obscene acts and songs
- 344. Punishment for criminal intimidation In cases of extreme ragging that includes violence:
- 345. Punishment for voluntarily causing hurt
- 346. Voluntarily causing hurt by dangerous weapons or means
- 347. Punishment for voluntarily causing grievous hurt
- 348. Voluntarily causing grievous hurt by dangerous weapons or means in case a ragging victim has lost his/her life:
- 349. Punishment for culpable homicide not amounting to murder
- 350. Abetment of suicide
- 351. Attempt to murder



Responsibilities of Anti Ragging Squad

Anti-Ragging Squad will be working under the Monitoring of Anti Ragging Committee and will seek advice from the Anti-Ragging Committee. The functions of Anti-Ragging Squad will be to keep a vigil and stop the incidences of Ragging, if any happening / reported in the places of Student aggregation including, Classrooms, Canteens, Buses, Grounds, Hostels etc. The Squad will also educate the students at large by adopting various means about the menace of Ragging and related Punishments there to. Positive reinforcement activities are adopted by Anti-Ragging Squad for orienting students and molding their personality for a better cause. They shall work in Consonance and Guidance of Anti Ragging Committee.

The college maintains a Grievance and anti ragging cell for redressal of students' grievances to maintain a harmonious educational environment in the campus.

Objectives of Student's Grievance and Anti Ragging Cell:

- To help students to express their grievances frankly without any hesitation or any fear of being victimized in accordance with the rules and regulations of the college.
- To resolve student's problems regarding ragging in fair & impartial manner.
- To ensure healthy coordination between students and staff.
- To ensure that a student is not deprived of the services offered by the institution for which she/he is entitled.
- The suggestion / complaint box is set up in front of the principal's and vice-principal's office, in which students write their grievances and their suggestions for improving academics / administration in the college.
- Advising all employees to have affection for students.
- To maintain a healthy environment for the holistic development of both men and women studying in the college.
- A student making any offence regarding gender discrimination, eve-teasing, disrespectful acts or words are dealt with severity and can lead to dismissal of the student from the college.
- Ragging is a criminal offence, therefore, any students found indulging in ragging will face immediate expulsion and legal action will be taken against them.

Procedure for lodging grievance and anti ragging:

The college provides various platforms where a student can lodge her/his grievances.

- Students can feel free to make a written complaint in the drop box in front of the principal, vice principal's office and departments.
- The Grievance and anti ragging Cell will take action on those cases which have been forwarded along with necessary documents.
- The Complaint Cell will assure that the complaint is properly resolved within the stipulated time frame provided by the cell.



The education institution shall constitute an Anti-ragging and grievance committee to take appropriate decision in regards to punishment or fine, depending on the facts of its incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendation of the Anti-Ragging cell.

Punishable ingredients of Ragging:

- Abetment to ragging
- Criminal conspiracy to rag
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging
- Public nuisance created during ragging
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- Wrongful restraint
- Wrongful confinement
- Use of criminal force
- Assault as well as sexual offences or even unnatural offences;
- Extortion
- Criminal trespass
- Offences against property
- Criminal intimidation;
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above-mentioned offences against the victim(s);
- Physical or psychological humiliation.
