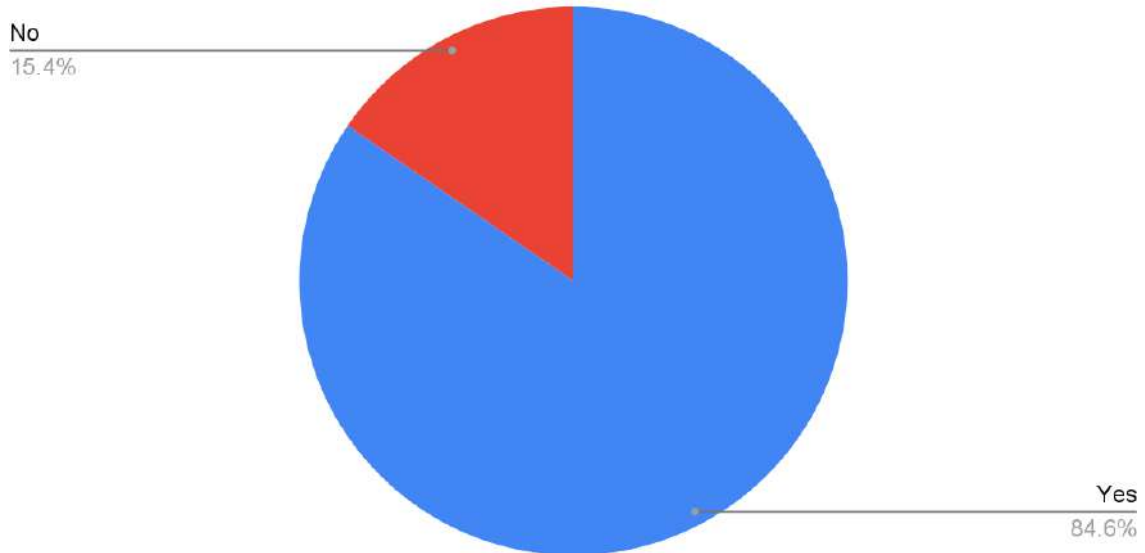


Q 2. Are the learning outcomes (Programme Outcomes and Course Outcomes) displayed on college website?

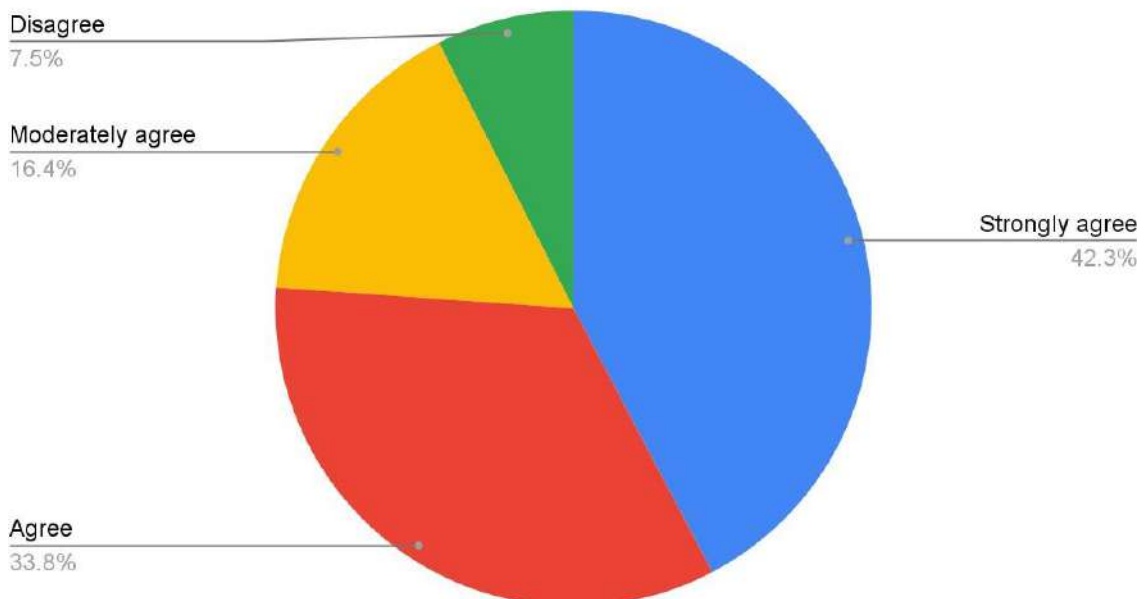

Q 3. Did you read the outcomes of the programme before taking admission?

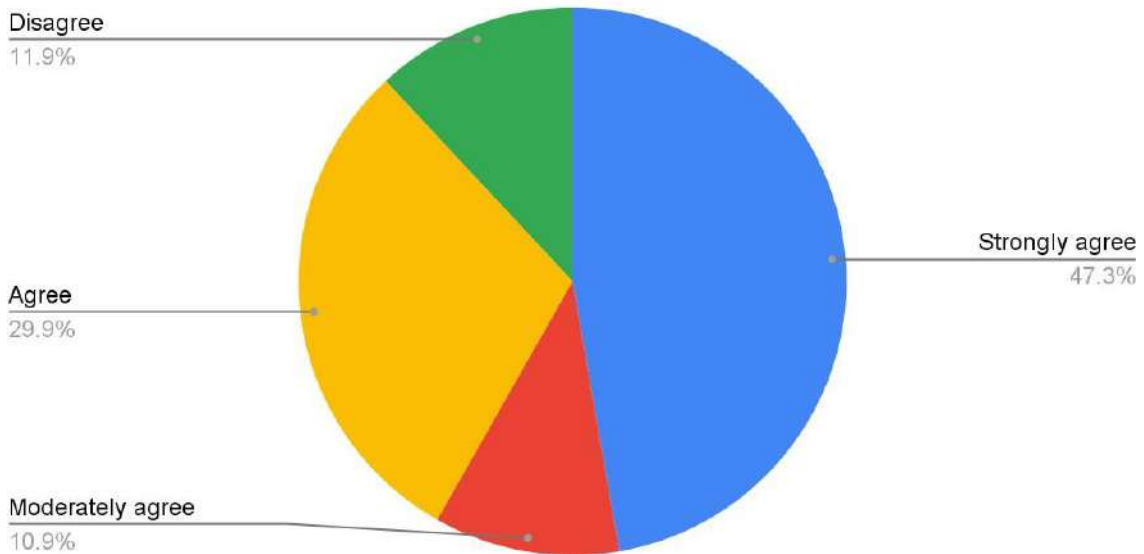


Q 4. I have learned what I expected from the program

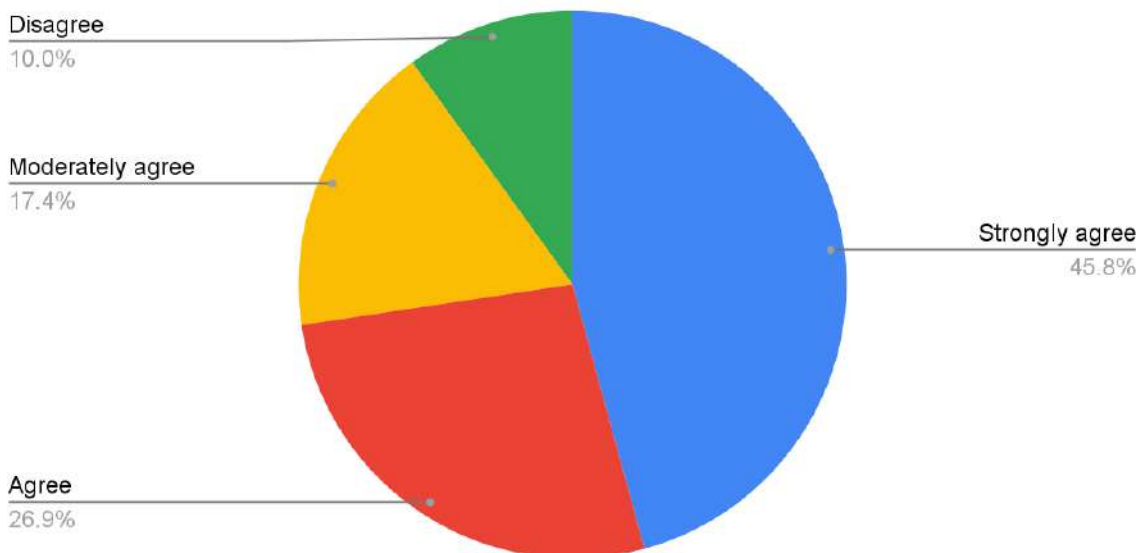

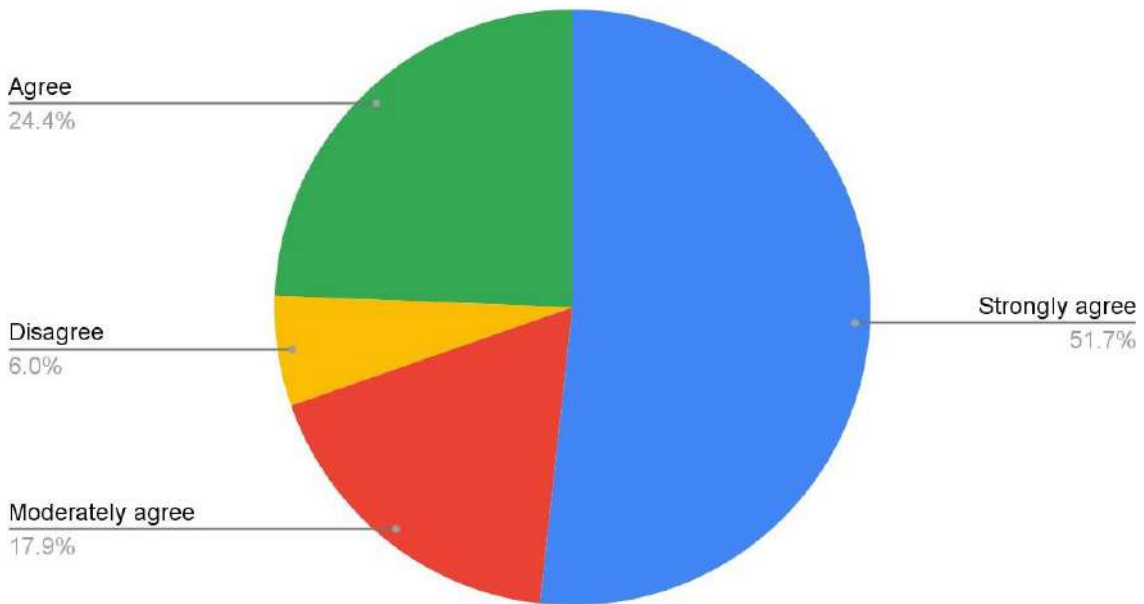

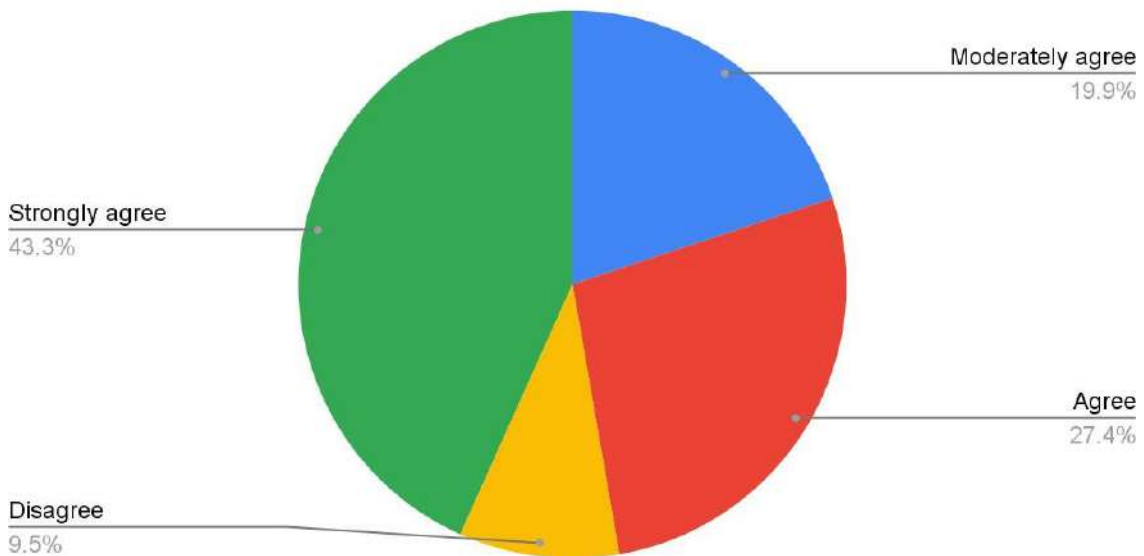

Q 7. The teachers provide sufficient knowledge to develop skills



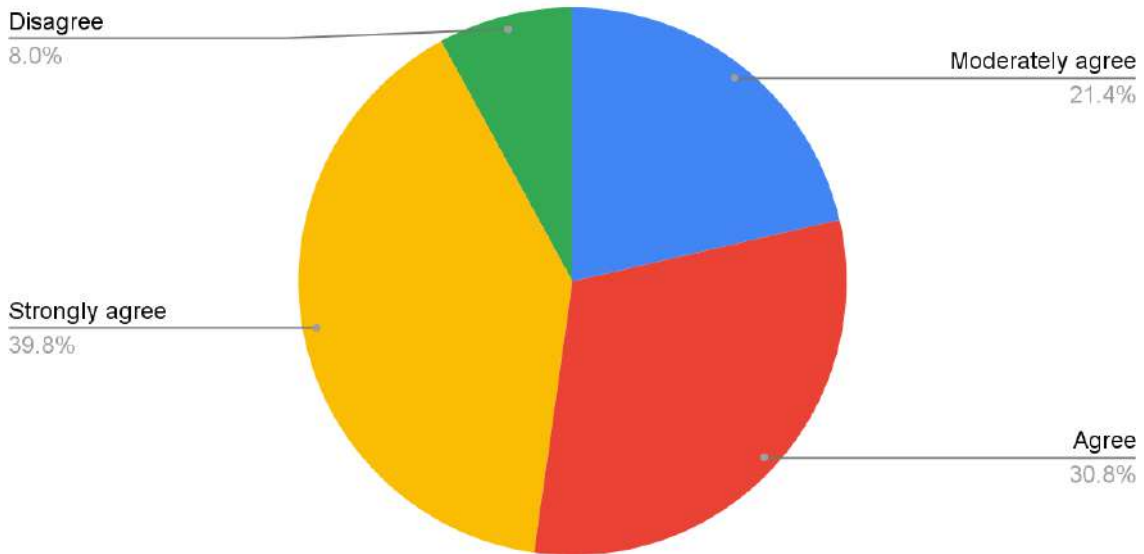
Q 8. Do you have idea of what jobs you might be able to get after completing the program



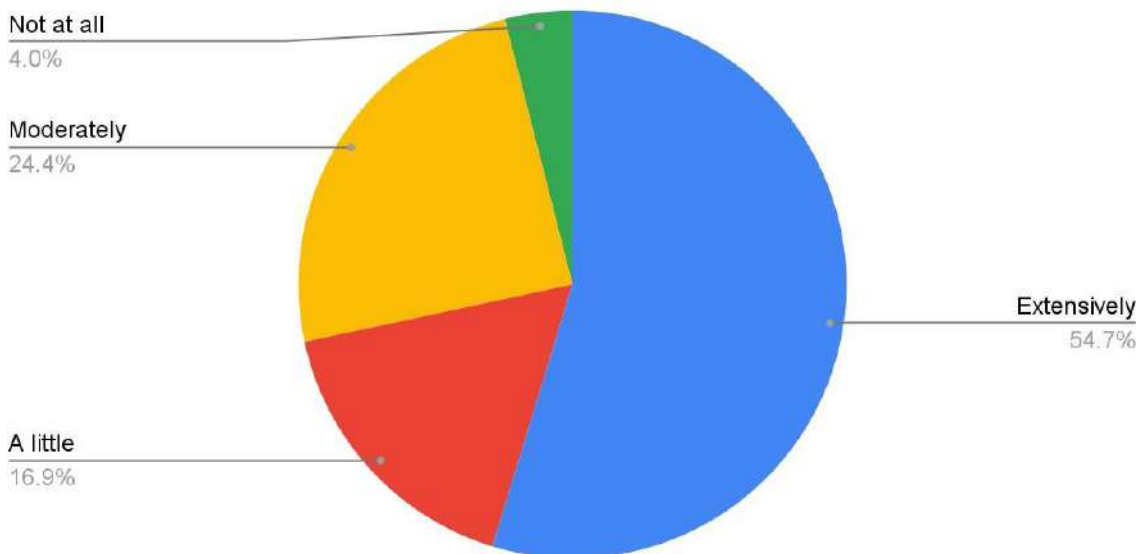

Q 9. Support services such as tutoring and counselling were adequate and helped me succeed in the program

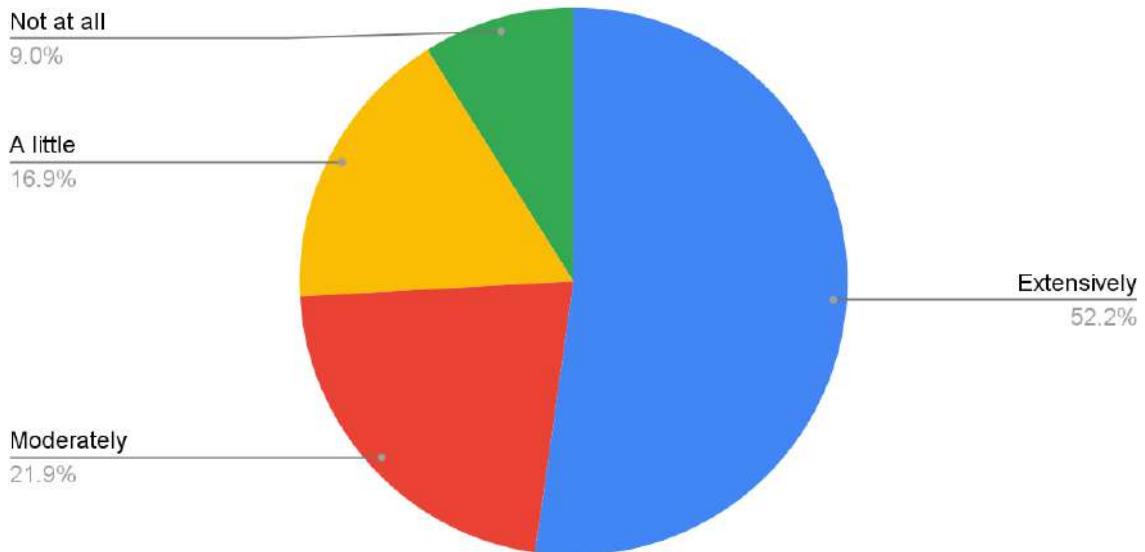


Q 10. How much did you write (assignments, tutorials, activities) in your program?

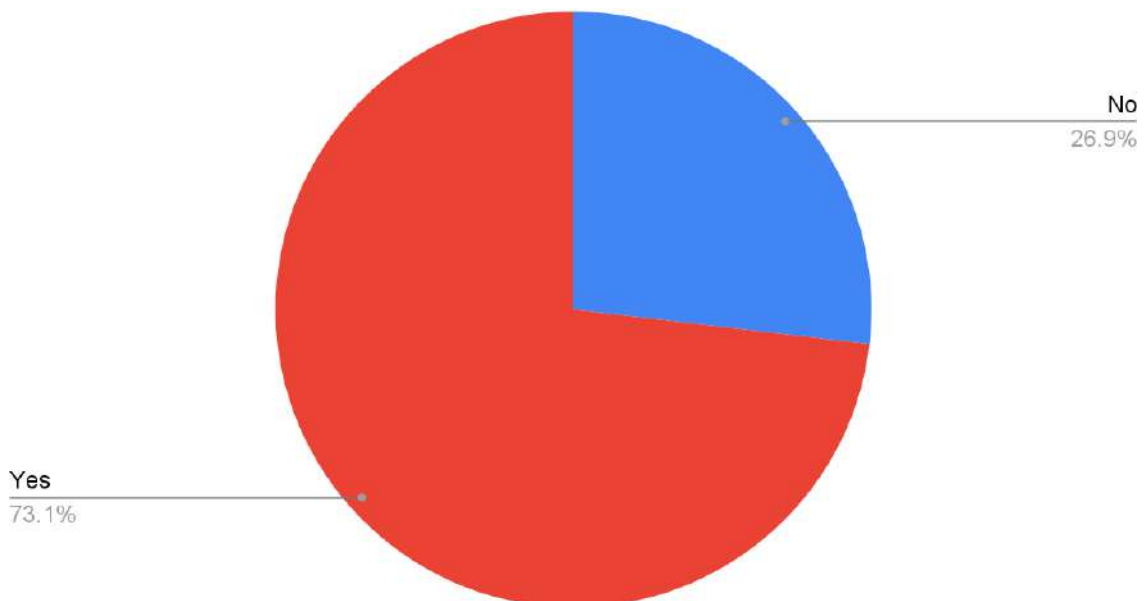

Q 11. Did your program contain activities to increase information technology literacy?

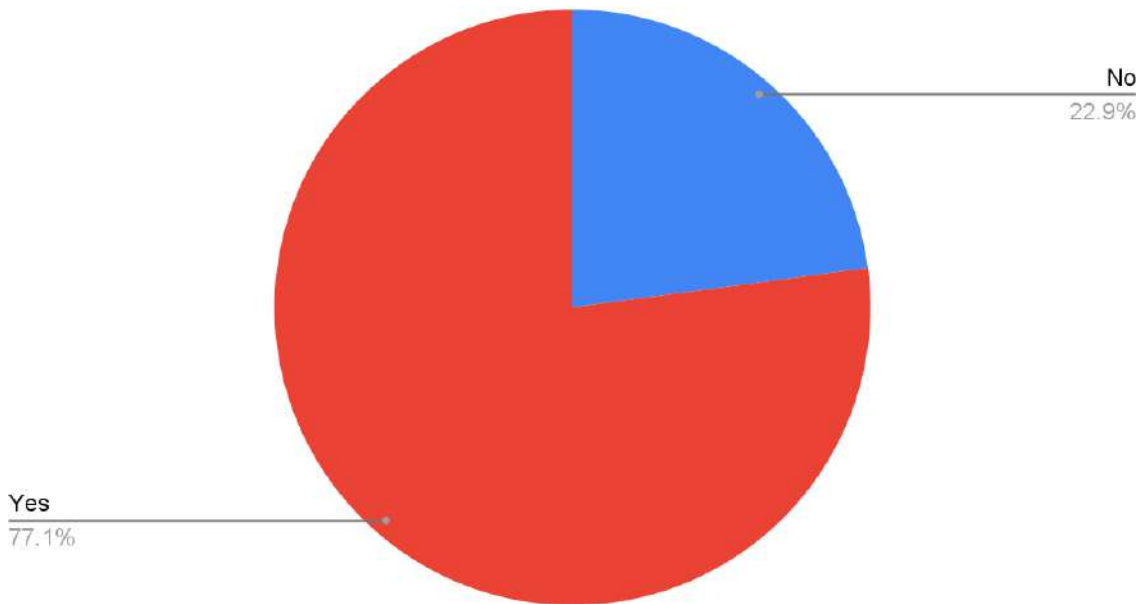


Q 12. Did your program include modes of critical thinking?

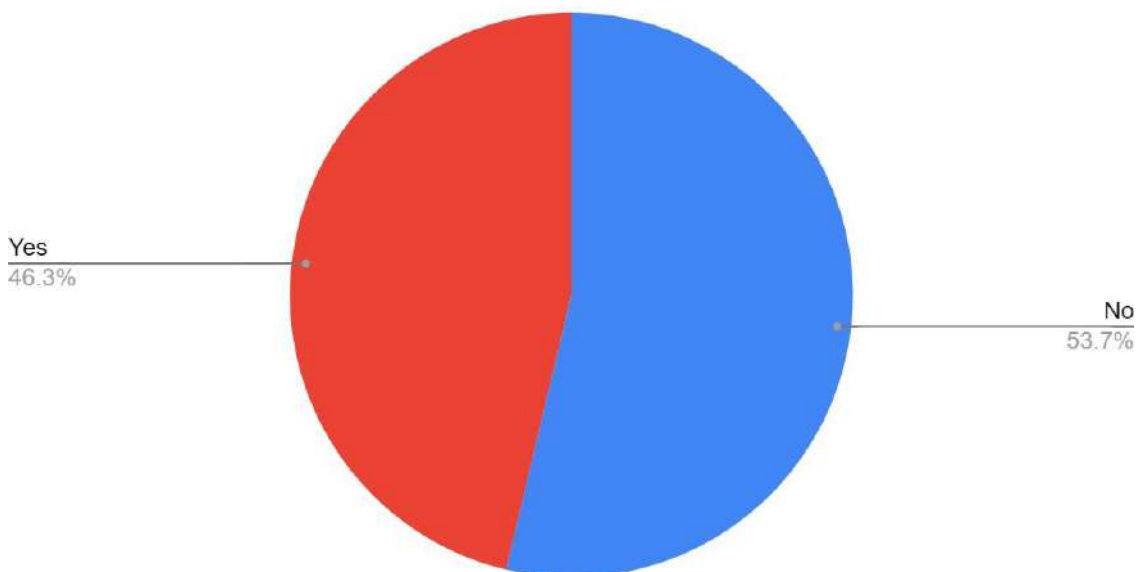

Q 13. Did your program include project work?

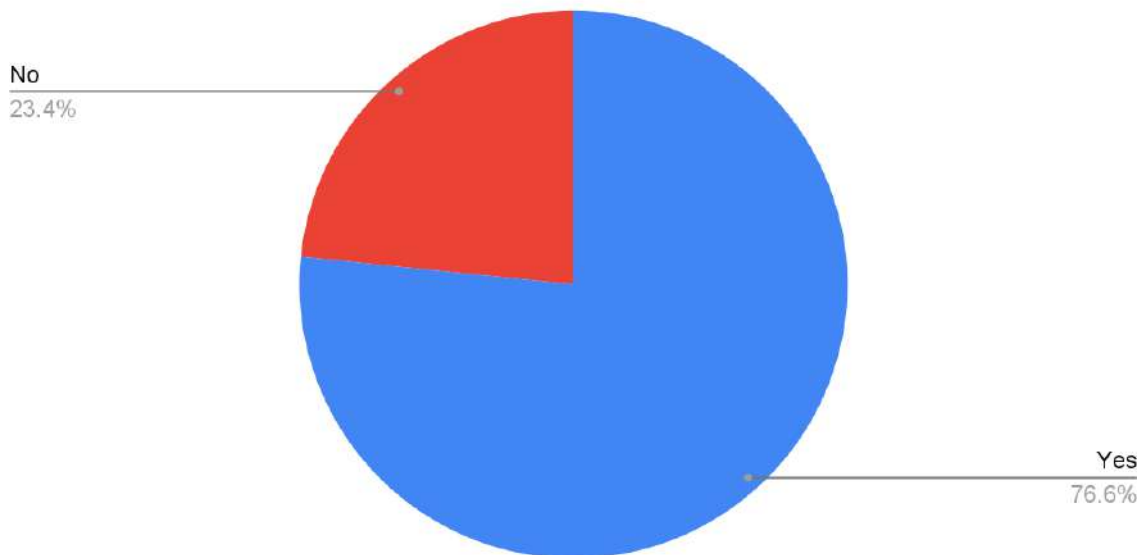


Q14. Did you participate in community based projects or service learning activities (NSS, NCC)?

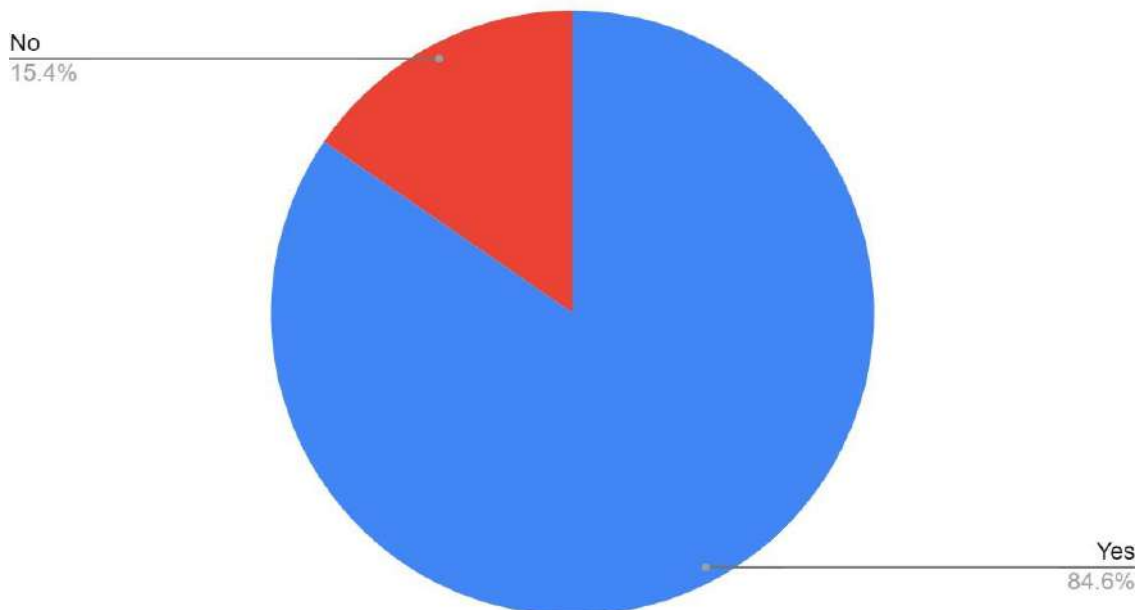

Q 15. Did your program include internship programs and exposure to industry as a part of syllabus?

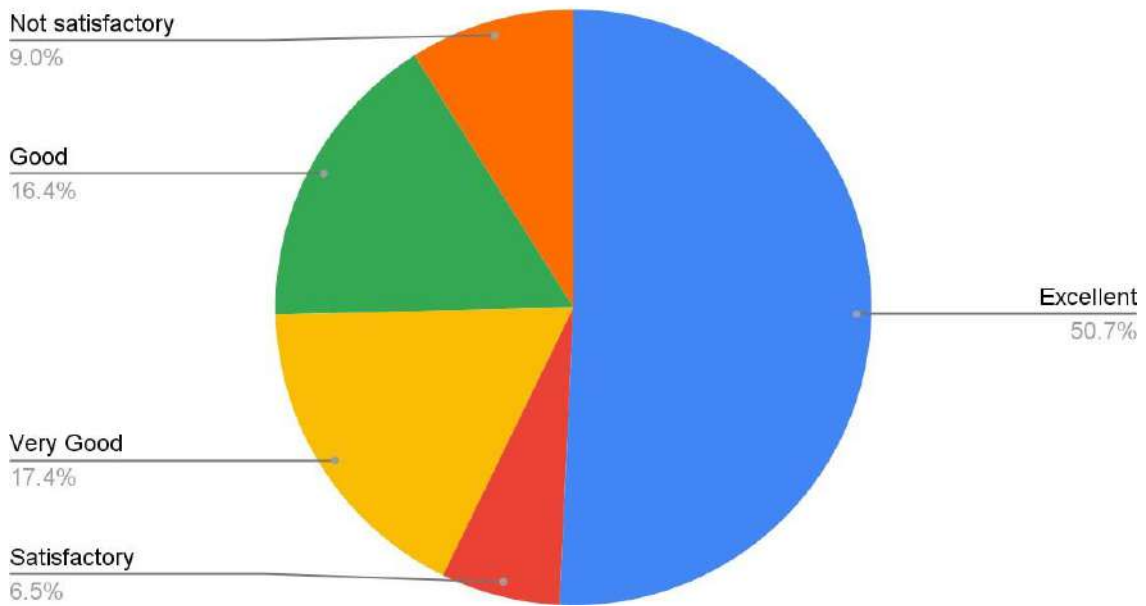

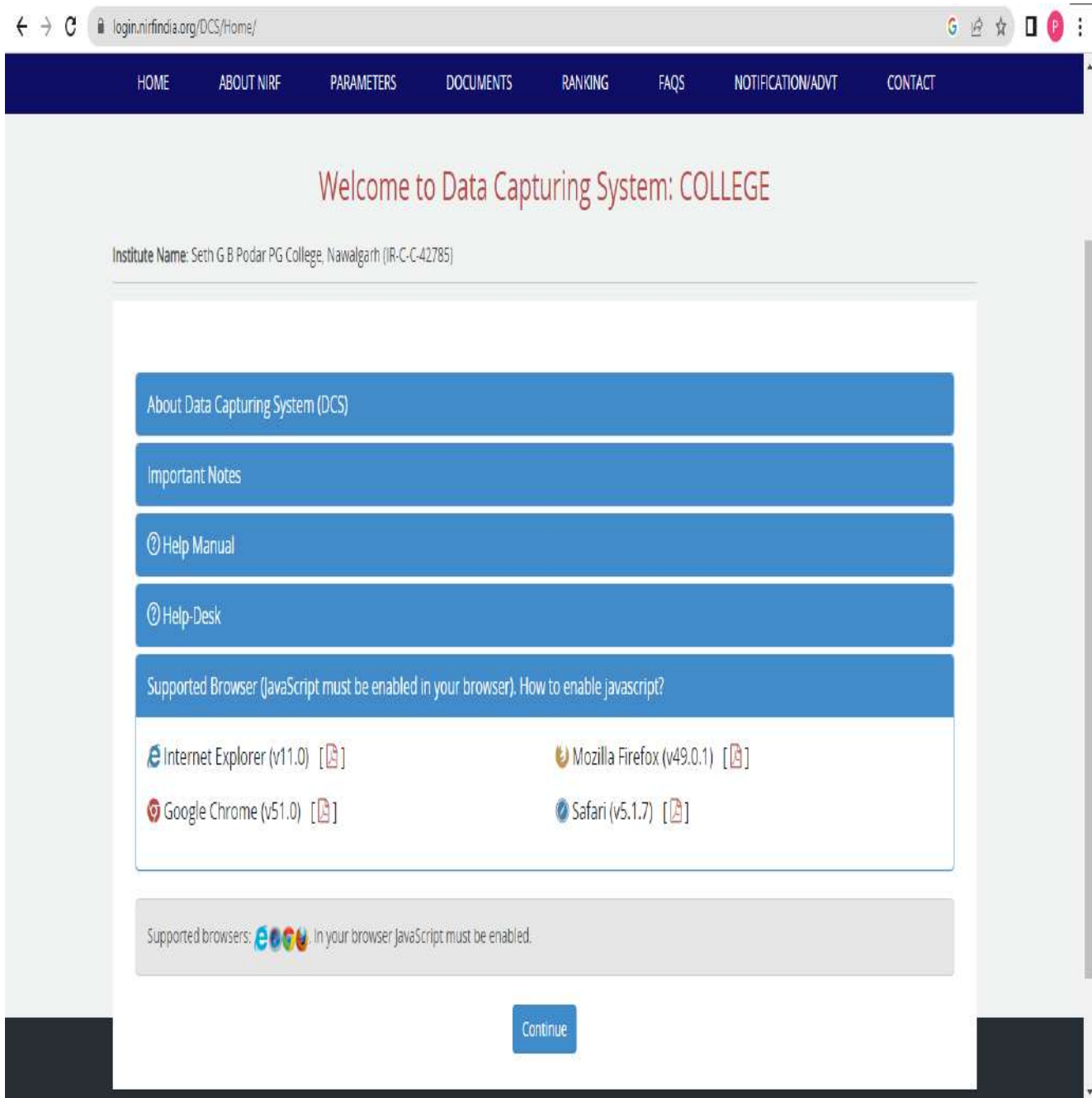
