**For Successful Entrepreneurs:**

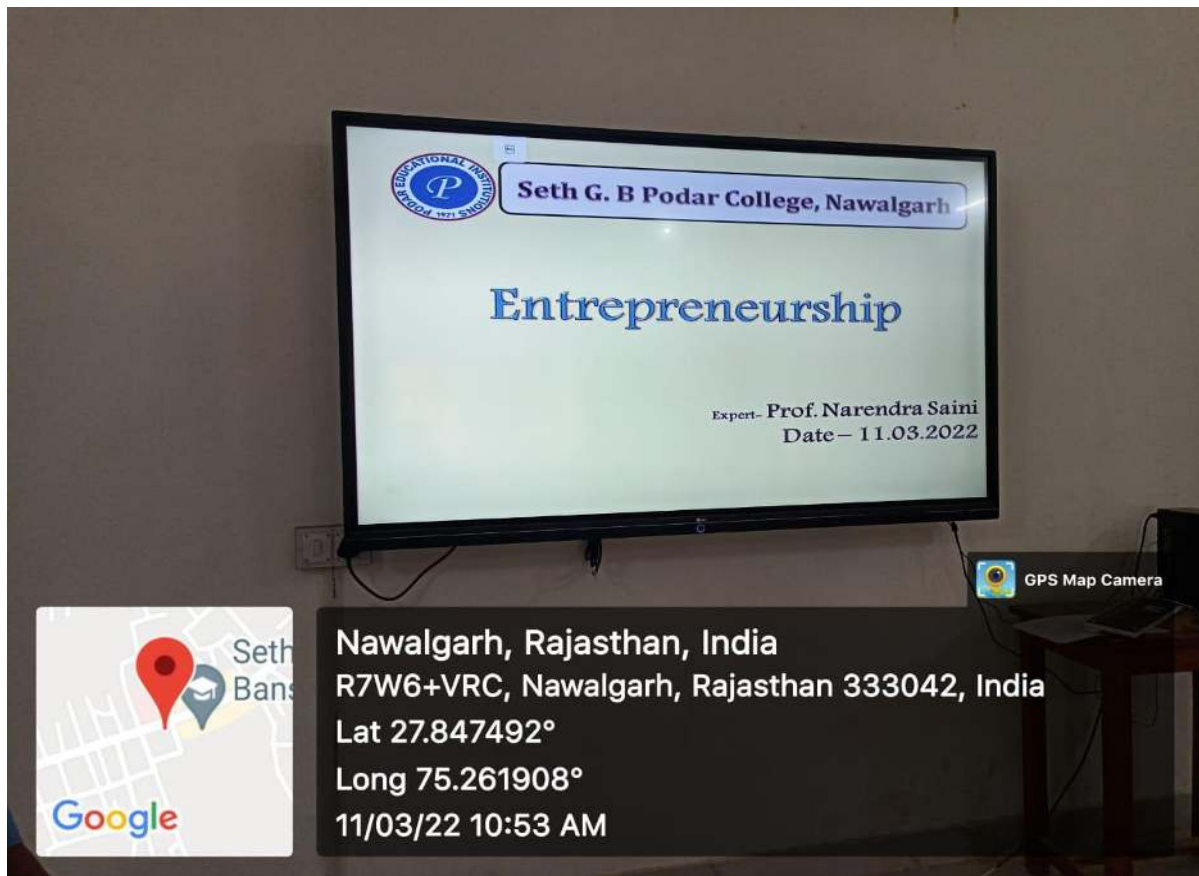
- Creative and Innovative

- Poor money managers

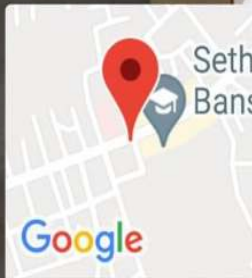
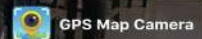

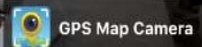
