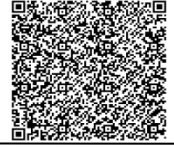

- There's less ad hoc learning.

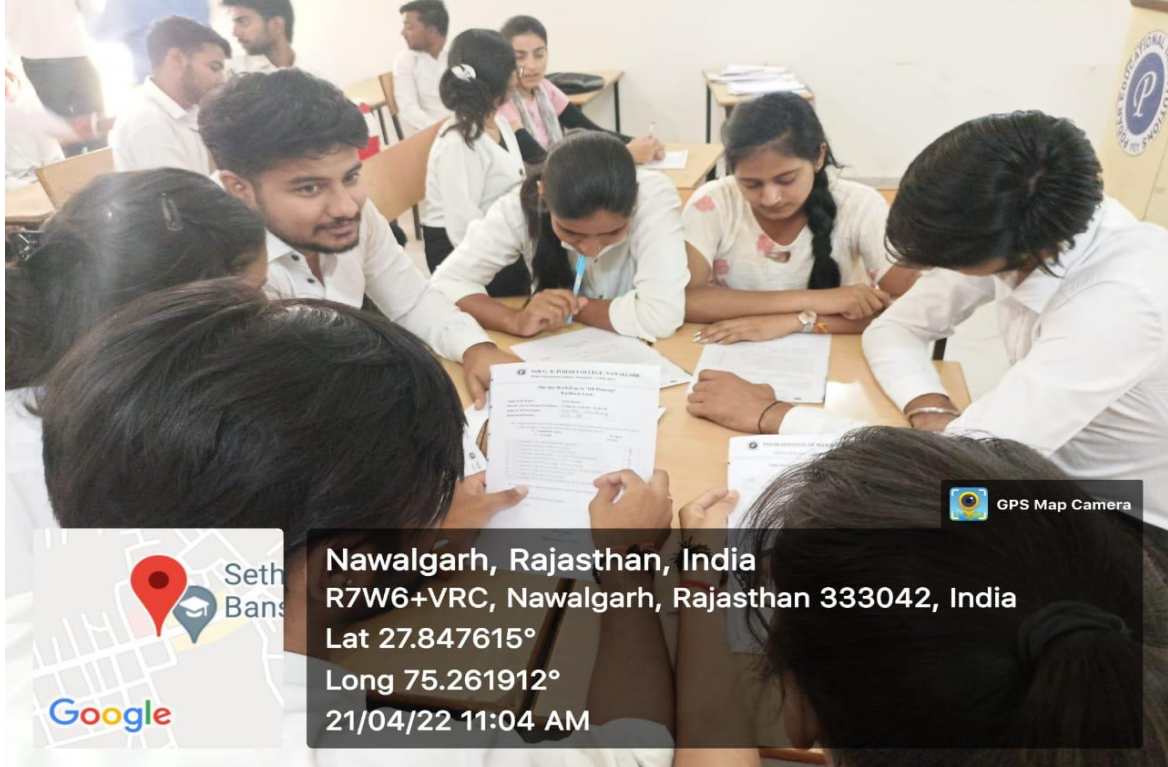
