

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Action Taken Report of Feedback 2022-23

As Principal of Seth Gyaniram Bansidhar Podar College, Nawalgarh, I am pleased to present this Action Taken Report based on the valuable feedback received from various stakeholders during the 2022-2023 academic session. Your feedback is instrumental in shaping the future of our institution, and we take it seriously.

Curriculum:

- **Feedback:** Students and alumni expressed a desire for more industry-relevant courses and electives. Teachers requested more flexibility in curriculum design.
- Action: We are collaborating with industry partners to develop new courses and workshops. We are also exploring options for online learning modules to offer greater flexibility.

Classroom Teaching:

- **Feedback:** Students appreciated engaging teaching methods and interactive sessions. Teachers requested additional training in technology integration.
- Action: We will organise workshops on innovative teaching methods and technology integration for faculty. We will also encourage peer observation and feedback to improve teaching practices.

Physical Facilities:

- **Feedback:** Students requested upgrades to some classrooms and laboratories. Alumni suggested improving accessibility features.

New Certificate Courses:

Computer Lab & Laboratory Facilities:

- Action: We have allocated funds for upgrading computer labs and laboratory equipment. We will prioritise upgrading based on student and faculty needs.

Use of ICT:

- **Feedback:** Students appreciated the use of ICT in teaching but requested more hands-on practice opportunities. Teachers requested additional training on ICT integration.
- Action: We will increase the availability of digital learning resources and provide more opportunities for students to use technology in their coursework. We will also conduct workshops for faculty on integrating ICT effectively in their teaching.

Library Facilities and Books:

- Action: We will expand our library collection in both print and digital formats. We will also explore partnerships with other libraries to provide access to a wider range of resources.

Merit Scholarships:

- Feedback: Students requested a more transparent and fair scholarship selection process.
- Action: We will review the scholarship selection criteria and ensure transparency in the application and selection process.

Career Counselling & Placement:

- **Feedback:** Students requested more career counselling sessions and internship opportunities. Alumni suggested strengthening industry partnerships.
- Action: We will strengthen our career counselling services by hiring additional counsellors and organising career fairs. We will also actively engage with industry partners to create internship and placement opportunities for students.

Sports Facilities & Events:

- **Feedback:** Students requested better maintenance of sports facilities and more frequent sports events.
- Action: We will allocate funds for sports facility maintenance and organise more sports events throughout the year. We will also explore options for creating new sports facilities.

Coaching for Competitive Exams:

- Feedback: Students requested specialised coaching for competitive examinations.
- Action: We will explore options for offering coaching classes for competitive examinations, either through in-house faculty or collaboration with external coaching institutes.

Canteen Facilities:

- **Feedback:** Students requested healthier food options and improved hygiene standards in the canteen.
