- 5. Foster a Supportive Environment: Create a supportive and inclusive environment where mentees feel comfortable sharing their concerns and seeking help.




Feedback Analysis Report

Students' Feedback


• Positive Feedback:

- More focus on entrepreneurship and start-up support was recommended.



- More industry-relevant courses and internships were recommended.






Total numbers of Stakeholder recorded feedback in 2023-24



Graphical Analysis of Student's Feedback Response






Graphical Analysis of Student's Feedback Response

Graphical Analysis of Alumni Feedback Response






Graphical Analysis of Alumni Feedback Response





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
Graphical Analysis of Teacher's Feedback Response








Graphical Analysis of Teacher's Feedback Response



Graphical Analysis of Employer's Feedback Response








Graphical Analysis of Employer's Feedback Response






