5. **Career Counselling and Placement Services:**

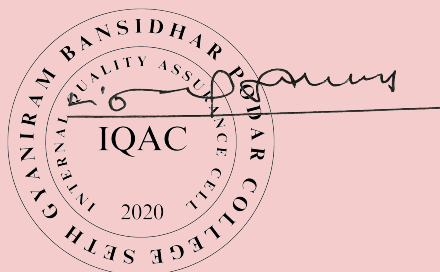
Students desire stronger career guidance and better placement opportunities to help prepare them for post-graduation success.

- **Workshops and Seminars:** Organize skill-building workshops on resume writing, interview techniques, and career strategy.

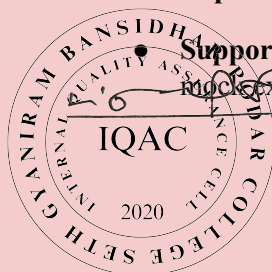
6. Revitalize Sports Facilities and Events:

1. Improve Teaching Quality:

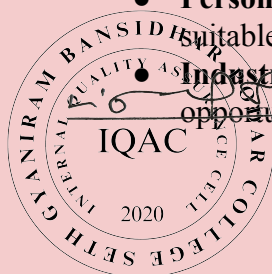
- **Innovative Teaching Methods:** Promote case studies, simulations, and group discussions to enhance learning experiences.

- **Resource Expansion:** Increase the acquisition of books, journals, and digital resources, ensuring easy access to essential materials.

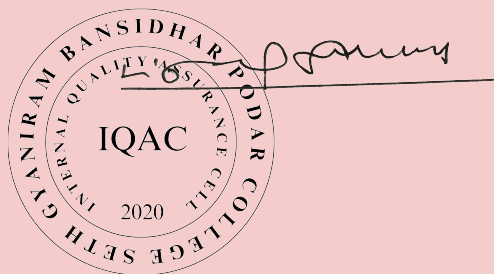
