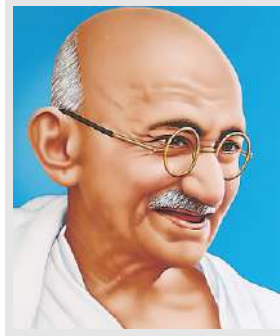

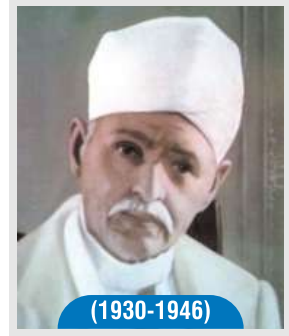

## 1. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Seth Gyaniram Bansidhar Podar College, Nawalgarh is one of the premier educational institutions in the Shekhawati Region which is run by the Anandilal Podar Trust. The college represents Science College, Commerce College, Arts College and Management Studies Institute along with the center of IGNOU. The trust also runs Teachers Training College and ITI for vocational courses. It has been a rare honour for the Trust to have Mahatma Gandhi as the First Chairman Trustee. It needs to be mentioned here that the Trust came into being as a result of the donation by Shri Anandilal Podar for the upliftment of education in the Shekhawati region. The college has grown from a Brahmacharya Ashrama established in 1921. Before the formation of the University of Rajasthan, the college had been affiliated to the University of Agra.

The college has the distinction of being the first undergraduate college in the erstwhile state of Jaipur. The college is an important part of the chain of institutions running under the Trust, the main objective of which has been to provide education. To give concrete shape to this objective, the Trust has established over 70 schools, Management Institutions, Medical Hospitals and Technical Institutions that are imparting education to thousands of students across the country.

The Vedica Podar Institute for Learning & Professional Development has been established with the primary objective of offering students and staff valuable opportunities to enhance their skills and knowledge. By promoting continuous learning both within and beyond the classroom, the institute seeks to empower individuals through a range of activities. ## **(A) Promoting Mental Health Awareness (Kangaroo Minds)**

In rural India, Mental health is often the missing conversation. People struggle with a range of challenges, including depression, anxiety, shame, and trauma but have no words for it, no safe spaces to talk about it, and no support system to fall back on. In both Nawalgarh and Beri, we saw this silence - in schools, in homes, in communities. People were carrying emotional weight they didn't know how to name. Those around them didn't know how to support them. They lacked the resources, the words, and the access to support, and what they sadly found in abundance was stigma.

Every Individual has Mental Health, and any individual irrespective of their age, gender, caste or socio-economic background can develop a Mental Illness, so why are we so shy or ashamed to talk about?

### **We asked ourselves some questions:**

What if emotional wellbeing and Mental Health conversations could be taken to everyone?

What if we began to meet people right where they were?

What if mental health didn't begin in clinics, but in communities?

What if we built for those who've never been asked?

What if every child could grow up learning the language of their emotions, and not just letters?

What can we do to make people realise that Mental health isn't a luxury, but a fundamental need, just as basic as water, as human as breathing?

What if looking after our mental health could also look like coming together, painting, running, talking, listening, or just being?

What if our little town of Nawalgarh could spark a bigger systemic shift in the culture of Mental Healthcare? This is how our work began not with a grand plan, but with a small invitation: "आओ, बात करें" (Come, Let's Talk"), and that changed everything.

We don't do just one thing we bring together many threads, weaving a grassroots ecosystem for mental health and emotional wellbeing through our various initiatives, some of them are...

### **Breaking the Silence: A Series of Conversations**

A series of panel discussions and community dialogues designed to break the silence, challenge stigma, and create awareness around mental health, emotional well-being, and social change, while bringing together Mental health professionals, educators, community leaders, and everyday changemakers.

### **Khushiyon ka Aashiana**

A heartwarming art-based initiative, we gave children a canvas to express their emotions and aspirations about the cities they dream of, the homes they imagine, and the safe spaces they long for. Every drawing, every brushstroke tells a story of hope, belonging, and the desire for a kinder, more accepting world.

### **Nawalgarh Speaks: A Mental Health Survey**

A first-of-its-kind mental health survey that captures the real challenges and emotional well-being needs of individuals in Nawalgarh. By listening to voices across Nawalgarh, this report highlights pressing mental health concerns, the stigma surrounding them, and actionable solutions.

### **Sneha Circles**

A unique child and caregiver focused initiative that creates safe spaces for meaningful conversations about emotions, resilience, and wellbeing through stories, art, drama and film. The program ensures that children build lifelong emotional intelligence skills.

### **Sneha Utsav: Bhavnaon ka Mela**

A vibrant Mental Health and Wellbeing Fest, Sneha Utsav focusses on bringing together children, families, educators, and mental health advocates in a safe space filled with learning, creativity, and open discussions alongside activities like storytelling, yoga, movement and expressive arts, and expert-led talks.

### **Walk for Mental Health**

Through the means of posters and a rally through the town of Nawalgarh to mark occasions like World Suicide Prevention Day and World Mental Health, this initiative aims to use Awareness Days to spread education on the importance of Mental Health, challenge the stigma and spark these conversations.

### **Yoga and Mindfulness**

Recognising the power of yoga, meditation and mindfulness as both a form of self-care and a healthy coping mechanism, we organize regular classes for the students and faculty of the Trust's institutions (both as a part of and outside the school timetable) as well as for the members of the wider community.

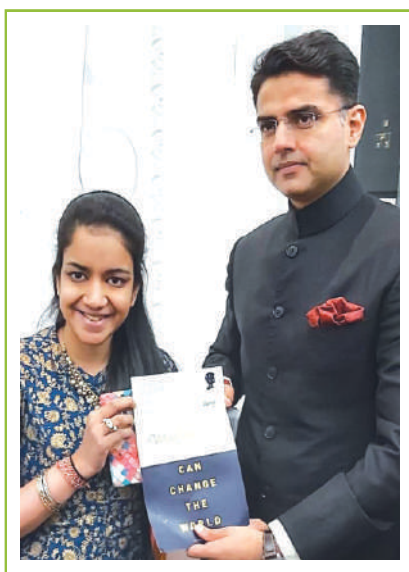

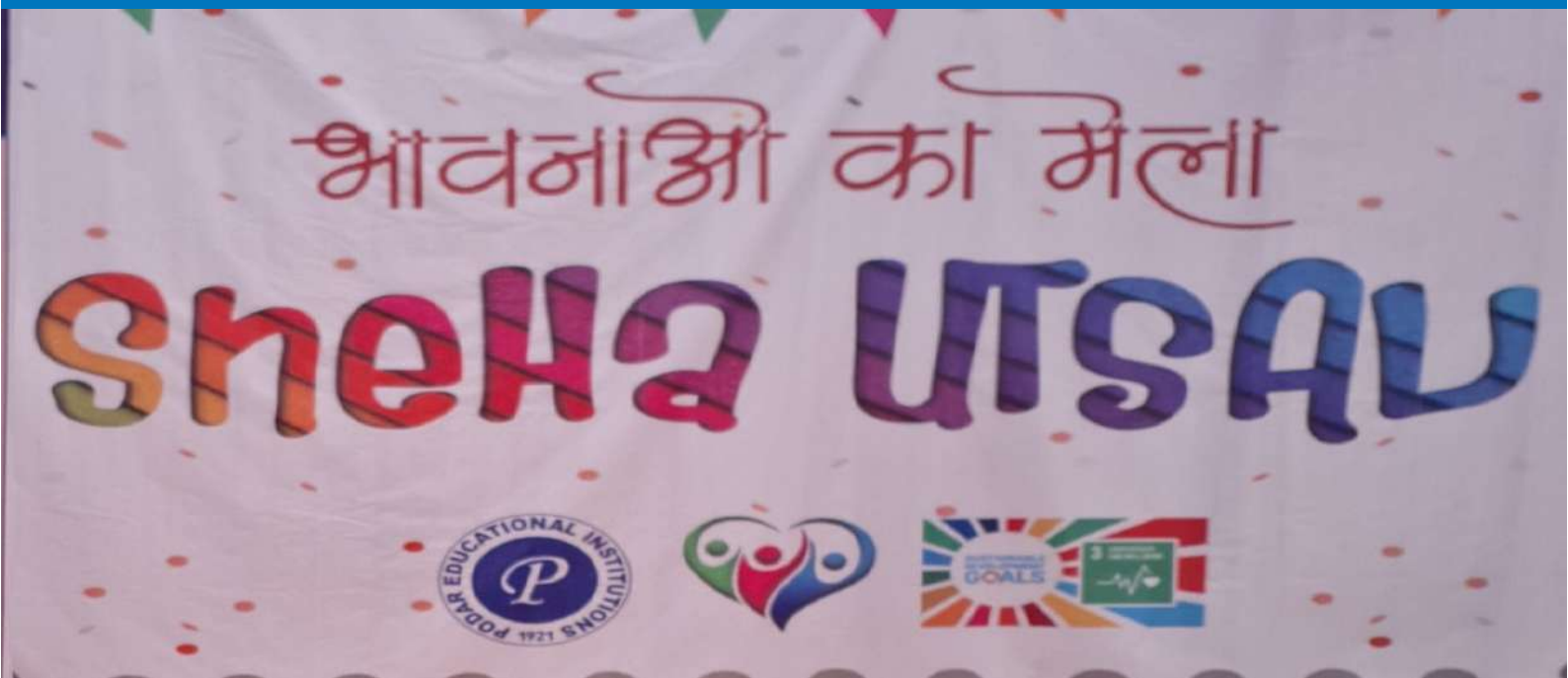

The students joining NCC have a special opportunity of serving the nation by becoming officers in the armed forces. Students having a 'C' certificate of NCC are exempted from appearing in the written examination held by the Indian Defence Academy. Such students are directly interviewed by the Service Selection Board and are recruited as officers if found medically fit.

Mr. Vinod Kashawa , a student of our College (2011-12) had been selected to participate in the Republic Day Parade. He had been one of the sixty cadets selected out of 1600 cadets from all over India. Sgt. Rajesh Nehra had been selected for the Para Jumping Course (one month) at the Air Force Stadium, Agra. He was the only male cadet from Rajasthan selected for jumping from an airforce plane from the height of 2500 feet. Recently, four of our NCC cadets have been selected in the Indian Air Force and the best NCC award was given to the unit of our College.

Mr Hemant Bhichchar (Under officer in NCC), a student of our College participated in the Republic Day Parade in New Delhi in the year 2019.

## NSS (National Service Scheme)

The College has two units of the NSS functioning under the ministry of HRD (Human Resource Development), government of India. Apart from the plantation drives and welfare work aimed at women and children, the NSS units of the College carry out a special programme to create awareness against drug abuse, AIDS and several social ills. Under the special camping programme of the NSS units, three villages have been adopted for dedicated and focused services. The adoption of villages for concentrated services has now become the regular features of the NSS programmes at the College. The government of Rajasthan has recognized the social service rendered by two units through award of certificates during past sessions.



## Rovers & Rangers

The organization is a voluntary, non-political, educational organization for young students who are open to all without discrimination on the basis of origin, race or creed. The purpose of the organization is to contribute to the development of young students in achieving their full physical, intellectual, social and spiritual potential as individuals so that they become responsible citizens and members of the local, national and international communities. Rovers participate in various camps and fairs the prominent ones being Jhunjhunu Camp, Mount Abu Camp, Rajyapal Puraskar Camp, Rashtrapati Award Camp, Lohargal Dham Fair, Baba Ramsa Peer Fair Nawalgarh, Bikaner Camp & Pushkar Dham (Ajmer) Fair to name a few. Dr. Sanjay Kumar Saini, Prof. B. Adm. completed the course of Rover Scout Leader and has been appointed as Rover.



## 16. CODE OF CONDUCT

- (a) No club or organization of any kind shall be formed by the students without the prior written permission of the college Principal.
- (b) No meeting/assembly shall be held by the students without prior written permission of the Principal. Students are also required to seek the permission of the Principal in written form to invite guests to meetings/assemblies.
- (c) The students are required to maintain decorum in the college and use their free time usefully at the NRSC (Non-resident Student Center) or at the library. Students must not aimlessly roam around the campus.
- (d) The students must not damage any college furniture and property. They should avoid crossing the lawn and plucking flowers or leaves of plants.
- (e) Students must note that they require a good character certificate. It shall be fulfilled only if they maintain discipline and decorum in the college.
- (f) The students must note that smoking and use of other tobacco products, intoxicants or drugs in any form at public places such as an educational institution has been banned by the government through an act of legislation. Therefore, the students found smoking or using intoxicants of any kind in the college campus shall be penalized.
- (g) Students must ensure at least 75% attendance in aggregate in their subsidiary, compulsory and optional subjects/papers in order to be eligible to appear in the University examinations.
- (h) Following the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the admission of a student will be canceled if he/she is found indulging in ragging of any sort. Any instance of this nature will also be reported to the police.
- (I) Uploading Program Video/ Photos on social media which may harm the reputation and good-will of the institution will be treated as a serious offense. Strict action will be taken against students indulging in such offenses.

## 17. ADMISSION RULES

The prospectus with the admission form is available at the cash counter of the college on a pre-payment of Rs. 500/-. A duly filled admission form with attested copies of all the required documents is to be submitted at the registration.

Documents required with the admission form:

- (a) Three self-addressed postcards.
- (b) Original mark-sheet of the qualifying examination with three photocopies.
- (c) Photo copies of the mark-sheet of part I, II and III of bachelor's programme (for admission in PG previous class).
- (d) Two recent passport size photographs.
- (e) Transfer certificate (for new entrants).
- (f) Candidates qualifying from other universities/boards need to submit their original migration certificate for enrollment in this university.
- (g) Photocopy of secondary school certificate/mark-sheet having date of birth (for new entrants).
- (h) Certificate of participation in inter school/collegiate games & sports, NCC or cultural events for bonus marks merit for admission (if any).
- (I) SC/ST/OBC students should enclose certificates of their category/caste.

- The eligibility for admission to various courses in the college is in accordance with the norms determined by the Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Shekhawati University, Sikar and the admission rules published by the Commissioner of College Education, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur.
- For postgraduate classes, the last date for the submission of the admission form is 15 days after the declaration of the result of the qualifying examination.

- Last date for the submission of the filled admission form for the students of part I of B.A., B.Com., B.Sc., BBA, will be the same as announced by the University/Directorate of College Education. For other classes the last date for submission of the filled admission form is June 30 of the respective session or 15 days after the declaration of the result of the qualifying examination.
- The claims for reservation and relaxation in admission are subject to availability of seats and the rules laid down by the Commissioner of the College Education, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur.
- A candidate recommended for admission shall have to pay fees by the date notified by the college office. In case he/she fails to do it, his/her admission shall stand canceled.
- The Principal reserves the right to reject any application for admission without assigning any reason.
- Students are normally not allowed to change their subjects once opted. Hence, they must choose the optional groups carefully. Subject to the availability of seats, students can change faculty/optional groups or subjects with the permission of the Principal within 15 days of the last date of admission. A student who wants to change his/her subject will be permitted to change only one subject. A student can avail the facility only once on payment of Rs. 50/-
- The management has the discretion to close a class/section having less than 10 students in a session. In such cases all the fees paid by the students of the class, except that for the prospectus, will be refunded. Registration and identity card will be refunded on the production of a "No Dues" certificate. Such students must ensure his/her eligibility to the course in which he/she is admitted.

University Examinations, Class Tests and Home Assignments

Students will be required to procure and produce a "No Dues" certificate in order to be able to appear in the University Examinations, both for theory and practical.

Students of every class will be required to appear in term tests held between August and February.

Students of every class will also be required to submit home assignments of every subject when asked by the faculty.

Students also have to appear in PUT in the month of January/February every session.

The Anandilal Podar Trust, Nawalgarh provides Late Shri Kantikumar R. Podar Memorial Scholarship to those eligible students who will obtain more than 70% marks in their previous examination the students are required to submit the scholarship form in stipulated time.

## 20. FEES AND CHARGES

All students, whether existing or fresh seekers have to submit an application form, complete in all respects along with registration charge of Rs. 500/ (For Only First Semester) and Rs. 300/ (For Other Semesters)

The fees and charges may be paid in total or maximum in two installments as under:

**1st Installment (For Odd Semester):** (2/3rd of total dues) - will be deposited before 15 September 2025

**2nd Installment (For Even Semester) :** (1/3rd of total dues) - will be deposited before 15 January 2026

### Late fee :

From 16 January 2026 to 15 February 2026	-	Rs.1000/-
From 16 February 2026 to Onwards	-	Rs. 2000/-

If a student fails to pay the fee and late fee by this date even, his/her regular admission in the college shall stand canceled. If a student leaves the college after admission, the fees deposited by him/her shall be forfeited. In case he/she leaves the college after the expiry of the last date of admission, he/ she will be required to pay the remaining installment (s) of the fees of the course. If the student does not clear the dues at time of leaving the college, Transfer Certificate, Character Certificate and No Dues Certificate will not be issued to him/her. Students will be required to pay a forwarding fee as prescribed by the University at the time of submission of the examination form. The fees and charges, except Caution Money are not refundable in any case. The Caution Money can be claimed within three years from the date of leaving the college. No claim for the refund of Caution Money will be entertained after the lapse of three years. In the case of unforeseen circumstances, the fees & charges are subject to change in the middle of the academic session by the college Management. 50% discount in tuition fees would be given to all faculty or staff members working in any of the institutions run by the Anandilal Podar Trust, should his/her wards get enrolled in any of the programmes in Podar College.
