Objectives of SEDGs Cell

- 1. Protection of Constitutional Rights**
To protect and safeguard all constitutional rights of students belonging to Socio-Economically Disadvantaged Groups (SEDGs).
- 2. Inclusive Educational Environment**
To ensure that the college environment remains inclusive, safe, and secure for students belonging to SEDGs.
- 3. Academic and Emotional Support**
To provide socio-emotional and academic mentoring through counselling, guidance programmes, and monitoring mechanisms.
- 4. Bridge and Orientation Courses**
To ensure proper implementation and monitoring of orientation programmes and bridge courses designed to assist SEDGs students.
- 5. Participation in Academic Activities**
To promote and ensure greater participation of SEDGs students in academic, cultural, and institutional activities.
- 6. Implementation of Government Policies**
To ensure proper implementation of government policies, including **reservation policies, scholarships, and welfare schemes** meant for SEDGs students.
